CC SENOR FROG (15.58) broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.65 final 1/8) vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort (15.46) he broke in at the start, losing -1/2 length, drifted in (2-lanes) to the gap, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end (9.80 final 1/8) vs. tougher rivals. Class dropper carries the highest ratings based on adjusted clocking.

OTHERS:

FRANKLY TOO (15.66) broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage midway, gradually pulled clear late (9.88 final 1/8) from the rail. Prior effort (15.52) he bumped at the start, caught in tight quarters early, -1 length midway, kept to his task to the end (9.77 final 1/8). (Q) 05/17 BEST over DYNASTY NOW (12.2-12.3) Worked inside. Fractious in gate, broke in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride, hand shoved, +1/2 length midway, tapped twice thru the final ½, responding strong. Plenty left. GRADE: B+ DRILL. Wins with a clean trip!

OTHERS:

SPEEDY OTOOLE (15.54) hesitated at the start, losing -1 length, bumped, raced -1 ½ length past the gap, leveled midway (drifting in), finished out with good energy (9.74 final 1/8) vs. eventual Kindergarten Futurity winner BLACKBERRY CZECH. Prior effort (15.79) he hesitated at the start, losing -1 length, caught in tight quarters past the gap, -2 lengths midway, finished out very well (should have been much closer) thru the 9.85 final 1/8. (Q) 03/29 BEST (12.6-12.4) Worked outside. Hesitated at the start, quick in stride (lead), light hand ride, drifted in (+1/2 length) midway, asked left-handed, responding very well. Winning by +2 lengths. GRADE: C+ DRILL

FOREVER YOUR FIRE (18.06) hesitated at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards (9.68 final 1/8) in the Ed Burke Futurity trials. Prior effort (15.75) he broke -3/4 length slow, losing path, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (should have been closer). He posted a solid "B+" work on 05/01.

ROYAL WONDES CHOICE (15.80) hesitated at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished very well (not beaten badly for 2nd) thru the 9.93 final 1/8. (Q) 05/05 BEST over MS DASHIN RUNAWAY (12.4-12.5) Worked inside. Broke well, quick in stride (lead), hand shoved, +2 lengths midway, let run, responding well. Winning by +2 lengths. GRADE: B DRILL

CHICKS GONE (16.01) broke off balance at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (actually just missed 2nd). Prior effort he hesitated at the start, bumped repeatedly to the gap, caught in tight quarters (took up) midway. (Q) 04/28 BEST (12.6-12.4-12.7) worked in the middle. Broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), shifted out (losing action) midway, recovered, finished very well. Winning By +2 lengths. GRADE: B DRILL

T BONE JONES broke in at the start, swerved in (losing action) at the gap. (Q) 06/16 outworked (12.5-12.4-12.6) Worked inside. Broke in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, hand shoved, +1/2 length advantage midway, let run, responding okay. Losing by 1- length. GRADE: C DRILL

MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

MISS MOONLIGHT MAGIC (16.71) broke well, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, crushed her field with SPEED TO SPARE (9.57 final 1/8) while posting the night's fastest of 3 races. Prior effort (15.49) she bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing -1 length, leveled midway, finished strong (SHOULD HAVE WON) thru the 9.73 final 1/8 vs. EASIER. 3-back (15.71) she broke -3/4 length slow, raced -1 length past the gap, rallied strong for the score vs. EASIER. Razor sharp performer sports a winning record.

OTHERS:

COLD CRISTAL (15.38) swerved in at the start, losing -3/4 length, lugged in (2-3 lanes) past the gap, put in a big run midway, continued strong to the end (9.76 final 1/) vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort (15.39) she broke in at the start, lugged in (2-lanes) to the gap, put in a big run (lead) past the gap, gradually pulled clear late (9.74 final 1/8) when posting the night's fastest of 5 races.3-back she broke off balance at the start, losing -1 ½ length, losing path at the gap, was STRANGLED DOWN thru the final ½. Trouble prone performer draws a solid post and fits well on the class drop.

NO TIME TO SEPARATE (15.53) broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.76 final 1/8) vs. COLD CRISTAL. Prior effort she swerved out (bumped hard) shortly after the start. 3-back (15.38) she bumped at the start, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, gradually pulled clear late vs. maidens.

VENADO LOVE (16.98) broke well, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, kept to his task and just missed (5-way photo finish) thru the 9.70 final 1/8. 3-BACK he broke in, bumped at the start, drifted out, -1 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final ½ vs. tougher rivals. He is blessed with terrific gate speed.

DASHING SOLO (15.54) broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, gained the advantage past the gap, flashed good speed, held strong (9.74 final 1/8) vs. easier. Prior effort (15.59) he bumped, drifted out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, kept to his task to the end (should have won). He is racing in sharp form, but is also coming off a series of troubled trips.

HORSES TO WATCH:

HOW GOES IT broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, caught in tight quarters (losing path) at the gap, LEVELED TOO LAE (finished out full of run) thru the solid 9.29 final 1/8. Prior effort (17.22) he broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 ½ length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end despite lugging out late (9.40 final 1/8). Fresh performer makes his 1st start under G Morales (hitting at a 15% win clip from +180 day layoffs) and 15% clip from new faces (41 runners). Only guestion is the 300 yard distance.

BREANNA MOON (17.56) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 ½ length, raced -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.54 final 1/8) vs. productive field (CLASSIC SASSY CHECK came back and captured the Ivan Ashment Handicap in 19.93 at 400). Prior effort (17.79) she broke off balance at the start, drifted in (2-lanes) to the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end. She figures right in the hunt.

DE MOSS broke off balance, stumbled at the start, caught in tight quarters (clipped heels) early, not abused, STRANGLED DOWN thru the final $\frac{1}{2}$. Prior effort (17.43) he broke -3/4 length slow, drifted out, bumped past the gap (-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ length), finished strong (actually just missed 2^{nd}) thru the 9.48 final 1/8. 3-back (16.66) he broke well, drifted out (2-3 lanes) early, -1 length midway, losing path past the 1/16 pole, finished out full of run.

OTHERS:

RONSEPI (17.67) broke well, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.43 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.70) he broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, gained the advantage midway, gradually pulled clear late (9.79 final 1/8). 3-back (15.42) he broke in at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, gradually pulled clear late.

CASH HIM OUT fractious in gate, stumbled at the start. Prior effort (16.95) he broke off balance at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, flashed good speed, held strong (9.97 final 1/8). Fresh performer returns with a swift 18.0 flat gate work on 06/09.

ALOTA ACTION broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 ½ length past the gap, drifted in (losing path) midway in the Ivan Ashment Handicap. Prior effort (17.56) she broke well, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.43 final 1/8) vs. MALE RIVALS. 3-back (15.23) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, gained the advantage past the gap, gradually pulled clear late vs. EASIER.

HORSES TO WATCH:

SUZURAN DANCER broke out at the start, chased the 3-horse speed duel on the backside (-2 lengths), raced -2 lengths near the far turn (21.54 opening quarter), saved ground, lacked the needed response down the lane (6.38 final 1/16), BTL performance. Prior effort he broke well, chased the lone speed runner on the backside (-2 lengths), raced -3 lengths near the far turn (21.43 opening quarter), traveled evenly down the lane (6.55 final 1/16). Appears the LONE SPEED and his lone WIN came when controlling the tempo!!

POLLY'S DANCER arrives from BetFair Hollywood. He pressed a solid pace at Santa Anita (21.1 and 43.3 opening half) when competing against much better. Class dropper hails from winning connections. Worth a strong at the toteboard.

OTHERS:

WHO U FOOLIN broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, lagged -15 lengths (chasing the dueling pair) on the backside, raced -16 lengths near the far turn (21.50 opening quarter), finished out with good energy (far back) in a much needed out. Expect to see more speed for sure.....

WHOLELOTACONGRATS broke out, bumped at the start, chased the 3-horse speed duel on the backside (-6 lengths), raced -8 lengths near the far turn (21.79 opening quarter), finished out with good energy (6.27 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke well, dueled between rivals on the backside, shook loose (+1 length) near the far turn (21.75 opening quarter), got tired at midstretch.

WARREN'S VANWINKLE fractious, bobbled, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 length, chased the lone speed runner on the backside (-4 lengths), raced -6 lengths near the far turn (21.34 opening quarter), closed the gap entering the stretch, lacked the needed response in deep stretch (6.77 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke -1 length slow, raced -2 lengths on the backside, -2 lengths near the far turn, got tired at midstretch.

LIMERICK LANE broke in at the start, rank early, lagged -10 lengths mid-backside (chasing the dueling pair), raced -9 lengths near the far turn (21.40 opening quarter) 4-wide to clear at the top of the lane, rallied too late (clearly 2nd best) thru the 6.37 final 1/16. Prior effort he broke out, bumped at the start, chased the dueling pair on the backside (-6 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (21.20 opening quarter), found a huge rail opening entering the stretch, rallied to the front at the top of the lane, held gamely (6.84 final 1/16). Race figures to set up perfectly (STREET RAT CRAZY and HARD STORM are the speed rivals).

GAMBLING COWGIRL broke well, shook loose (+2 lengths) on the backside, controlled the slower 22.07 opening quarter, held gamely (6.52 final 1/16) vs. soft maidens. He will be facing multiple winners for the 1st time. Hoping to get 1st run at the possible dueling leaders.

STREET CAT CRAZY broke well, chased the lone speed runner on the backside (-1 length), -1 length near the far turn (21.20 opening quarter), dropped back -3 lengths as the pace quickened entering the stretch, collared the tiring leader near the wire (6.8 7 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke -1 length slow, chased the dueling pair on the backside (-4 lengths), -3 lengths near the far turn, 6-wide entering stretch, got tired at midstretch. Expect to see speed from this filly.

OTHERS:

HARD STORM broke out, bumped at the start, dueled outside one rival near the far turn (21.39 opening quarter), dropped back -1 length as the pace quickened entering the stretch, tired understandably at midstretch (6.66 final 1/16). Prior effort she broke well, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (21.36 opening quarter), gained the slim advantage turning for home, held gamely (6.84 final 1/16). She will give STREET CAT CRAZY plenty to work with.

WARREN'S AMD DAWG stumbled. Adds the blinkers.

HORSES TO WATCH:

RUNAWAY ENVY (17.89) balked badly at loading, broke -1 length slow, raced -2 lengths past the gap, never quit trying (thru the rapid 9.66 final 1/8) vs. eventual Ed Burke Million Futurity 4th place finisher WACH LINDA BALLET. Prior effort (15.63) she hesitated, swerved in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 ½ length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.60 final 1/8). Wins if she can put it all together.

BF FARMERS DAUGHTER (17.96) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, quick in stride, -1 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards (9.68 final 1/8) in the Ed Burke Million Futurity trials. Prior effort (15.62) she broke in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well for 2nd. 3-back (15.72) she broke -3/4 length slow, drifted in early, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end. She needs to maintain a straight course. She carries the most race experience.

OTHERS:

SWEET FEATURE GIRL broke -3/4 length slow, drifted in early, -1 ½ length past the gap (toss it out) when competing in fast clocking. (Q) 05/12 outworked (12.3-12.4) Worked outside. Bobbled at the start, -3/4 length midway, let run, responding strong Losing by -3/4 length. GRADE: B DRILL Watch for the improvement factor to really kick in.

THISPRIZEFLYS (Q) 06/02 BEST over BOOBIES BULLET (12.5-12.6) Worked inside. Missed workout. (Q) 05/10 outworked by SLATED TO BE FIRST (12.6-12.7) Worked outside. Broke out at the start, hand shoved, -1 length midway, never asked, finished strong (plenty left). Appearing better of the pair. GRADE: B DRILL

MERARI (Q) 06/12 worked solo (12.6) Broke in at the start, hand shoved, asked once midway, responding well. GRADE: C DRILL (Q) 06/12 outworked by FLY SWEET FLY and DIS ONE CAN FLY (12.5-12.24-12.4) Worked inside. Hesitated, bobbled shortly after the start, quick in stride, drifted in midway, asked left-handed thru the final ½, responding well. Losing by a narrow margin. GRADE: C+ DRILL

RUFF RIDER broke off balance at the start, losing –1 ½ length. (Q) 05/26 outworked (12.6-nt-12.5) Worked inside. Broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, hand shoved, even up midway, let run, responding well. Losing by -1 length. GRADE: C DRILL. (((())))

HORSES TO WATCH:

A REGAL PERFOMANCE (15.25) broke off balance, drifted in (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, crushed her field with SPEED TO SPARE (9.70 final 1/8) vs. easier. Prior effort (15.49) she bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.88 final 1/8). She improves her post and is eligible to post a stronger rating!

TIME AFTER TIME stumbled, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 ½ length, caught in tight quarters past the gap, took up repeatedly past the 1/16 pole, was RAGING with run crossing the wire, much BTL performance. Prior effort (15.70) she broke thru the gate prior to start, broke well, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (BIG EFFORT). Claimed from V Zamudio. Filly is coming off a series of troubled trips. Follow up closely.

OTHERS:

SHEZA HOT CATCH (16.89) bumped (pushed in) shortly after the start, right there past the gap, gained the advantage midway, just missed (9.62 final 1/8) from the rail. Prior effort (16.73) she broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in early, raced -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (holding 2^{nd}) thru the 9.59 final 1/8 from the rail. 3-back (15.51) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing-1/2 length, quick in stride, right there midway, kept to the end. Consistent performer is also coming off a series of troubled trips.

VELVET AND CHENILLE (15.69) broke well, drifted out (2-3 lanes) all the way past the gap, right there past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards (9.76 final 1/8) in a much needed outing.

GROUPIE (15.68) broke well, drifted in (lead) early, flashed good speed, losing lead past the 1/16 pole, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.85 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.60) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, just missed (9.87 final 1/8) when favorably drawn.

HORSES TO WATCH:

AUGUSTUS PRINCEPS (17.29) swerved in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 ½ length, raced -1 ½ length at the gap, leveled midway, absolutely flew for the score (9.22 final 1/8) from the rail. He worked in solid fashion previously (17.80 gate work). Skies the limit....

TWELVE STEPPER (15.18) broke off balance, bumped (took up) shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -1 ½ length past the gap, leveled midway, flew for the score (appearing much the best) thru the 9.68 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.26) he broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in early, raced -3/4 length past the gap, put in a big run midway, gained the advantage past the 1/16 pole, held strong (9.60 final 1/8). 3-back (15.55) he broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage early, losing lead past the 1/16 pole, just missed (9.60 final 1/8). Razor sharp performer lands an ideal post!

HAREMS LAST DASH (19.74) stumbled, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (not beaten badly for 3rd) vs. productive field (top 3 finishers qualified for the upcoming VESSSELS MATURITY). He definitely needed that one!

RUN NAKED returns from Sunland Park. He captured a local allowance event in 16.39 at this distance on 06/11/11. Check out his recent 18.0 flat gate work on 06/12.

OTHERS:

JUMPN SHAKE (17.50) broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 ½ length past the gap, bumped midway, gamely kept to his task to the end (thru the 9.48 final 1/8) vs. productive field (FROSTY YOUNGER and FLAMING OUT qualified for the upcoming VESSELS MATURITY). Prior effort (17.53) he broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage midway, held strong (9.52 final 1/8).

POT O CASH(16.71) broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, +3/4 length advantage past the gap, held strong (9.59 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.03) he was fractious in gate, broke off balance at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end. He is coming off a series of troubled trips.

AJS KISSNTELL (15.34) broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, just missed (9.68 final 1/8) vs. TWELVE STEPPER. Prior effort (15.33) he broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in early, put in a big run past the gap, right there midway, finished strong (holding 2nd) thru the 9.60 final 1/8. 3-back (15.46) he broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage midway, held strong (9.71 final 1/8).
