JESS CALIFORNIA BLUE hesitated, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort (15.56) he broke off balance, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, leveled midway, finished strong (9.79 final 1/8) vs. better.

HORSES TO WATCH:

DRIVING MISS DAZIE (19.91) broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (running behind horses) vs. eventual Super Derby winner DINERO. Prior effort (15.44) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong for 2nd (9.65 final 1/8) at 300. Filly fits much better!

A DIRTY FEATURE (17.61) broke well, quick in stride (lead), drifted out (3-4 lanes) at the gap, losing lead past the gap, battled back and just missed (SHOULD HAVE WON). Prior effort (15.46) she broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths at the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.60 final 1/8). 3-back (17.61) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 length, drifted in, bumped early, LEVELED TOO LATE. We haven't seen her best!

DOES SHE EVER (15.31) stumbled bumped shortly after the start, pushed in to the gap, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, was HARD TO RIDE (trying to lug out) thru the final 1/2 and should have been much closer when competing in night's fastest of 7 races. Prior effort (17.49) she broke in at the start, losing -1/2 length, shifted out (lead) past the gap, flashed good speed, just missed (9.52 final 1/8). She is capable of solid ratings but must maintain a straight course.

OTHERS:

A KOOL ZOOM (17.78) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, lacked the needed response thru the final 75 yards (9.60 final 1/8) vs. a troubled A DIRTY FEATURE. Prior effort she bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, caught in tight quarters throughout, shuffled back (losing path) past the 1/16 pole, finished out full of run (behind horses). 3-back (15.65) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.77 final 1/8).

BONOS LUCKY JEANS (15.43) broke in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, finished strong for the score (9.79 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.67) she broke off balance, bumped (pushed in) shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 lengths, leveled past the gap, put in a big run midway, continued strong (SHOULD HAVE WON). She is racing in sharp form!

TAC IT TO HEART (15.43) broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.63 final 1/8) vs. a much troubled DOES SHE EVER. Prior effort (17.61) she broke off balance, drifted out (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, finished out with good energy after losing her best chance. She draws another favorable post.

LR MISS ATINA (15.41) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, right there past the gap, finished strong for 2nd (9.60 final 1/8) vs. a much troubled A DIRTY FEATURE. Prior effort (17.56) she broke off balance at the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted in at the gap, put in a big run (lead) midway, just missed.

EASEFUL DINASTIA (16.71) broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, kept to her task to the end (thru the 9.54 final 1/8). Prior effort (16.65) she broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, kept to her task to the end (just missed).

HORSES TO WATCH:

SPAIN (15.88) broke -3/4 length slow, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.96 final 1/8) in a needed outing. Prior effort she broke off balance, bobbed shortly after the start, losing path past the gap (toss it out).filly figures to move forward based on her comeback effort.
