STRAWFINDERS JESSEE (19.78) broke -1 length slow, quick in stride, close up past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.63 final 1/8) vs. THERMONUCLEAR ENERGY. Prior effort (15.26) she broke off balance, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to her task (actually just missed 2nd) thru the 9.59 final 1/8. She is overdue!!

FIRST N FINAL (19.93) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, never quit trying (9.52 final 1/8). (Q) 07/15 BEST in 2-team drill (17.8-18.8) worked inside. Broke well, quick in stride, +5 length advantage past the gap, finished out full of run. GRADE: A DRILL Expect a stronger performance with the race under his belt.

GIVE ME SUM SUGAR hesitated badly, ducked out shortly after the start. (Q) 08/12 BEST over BLUE NOBLESSE (18.3-18.0) Worked outside. Broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), hand shoved, +1 length past the gap, never asked, finished strong (plenty left). Winning by +2 lengths. GRADE: A DRILL Fresh and dangerous based on solid work!!

NYMPH (19.99) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, bumped near the gap, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.63 final 1/8) vs. THERMONUCLEAR ENERGY. Prior effort (15.42) she stumbled, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (9.62 final 1/8).

TOUGH BROAD (100 yards) broke off balance at the start, quick in stride, finished strong for the score at 100. Prior effort (17.73) she broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards (9.62 final 1/8). She got her speed sharpen in last.....

FAVORITE KISS (20.14) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, losing lead at the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards. Prior effort (15.37) she bobbled, bumped, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, put in a big run (lead) midway, held strong at 300 yards.

JESSFLIPCOIN arrives from Turf Paradise. She posted a pair of fast works under B Vickery. Making her 1st start under the lights.

HORSES TO WATCH:

RAYSHAS PINK SKY (17.58) broke out, bumped at the start, bumped repeatedly to the gap, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (should have been much closer) thru the 9.51 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.14) she broke off balance at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, gained the advantage at the gap, gradually pulled clear late despite lugging inward near the wire (9.59 final 1/8). 3-time lifetime winner has encountered trouble in all of the outings!!

TOUGH TO FIGURE (17.64) broke well, quick in stride, drifted out early, shifted in past the gap (right there), gamely kept to her task to the end (just missed) thru the 9.68 final 1/8. Prior effort (19.95) she broke off balance, bumped back at the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, cleared past the 1/16 pole, finished strong (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.68 final 1/8. She is coming off 3 consecutive trips!

ONE SWEET RUNNER (19.79) broke out, bumped at the start, quick in stride, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (not beaten badly for it all) thru the 9.63 final 1/8. Prior effort (19.83) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, he strong (9.59 final 1/8). She keeps on firing bullets!
