JESS GOOD REASON (19.81) broke out at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.49 final 1/8) vs. runner-up HE LOOKS HOT. Prior effort (19.80) he was FRACTIOUS in gate, broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, just missed (tough loss) thru the 9.88 final 1/8.

TIME FOR JESS (19.91) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, drifted in early, raced -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (improving her position late) thru the 9.51 final 1/8. Prior effort (19.69) she broke out (3-4 lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length at the gap, put in a big run midway, gamely kept to her task and proved best (9.88 final 1/8). She will be facing male rivals.

CHAZAQ (19.69) broke in at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.63 final 1/8) when favorably drawn vs. 3 YEAR OLDS. Prior effort (19.69) he broke off balance, drifted in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, quick in stride, finished strong (just missed) thru the 9.62 final 1/8. HE WILL BE FACING OLDER RIVALS.
