OTHERS:

ALWAYS TRYING (15.67) bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, drifted in early, close up past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end at 300. Prior effort she broke -1/2 length slow, raced -2 lengths past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2. Her gate speed stamps her a contender.

RECKING BALL broke off balance, bumped at the start, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 vs. MADAM OF FIRE MV!

STUDIOS (100 yards) broke well, quick in stride (lead), held gamely at 100 yards vs. MAIDENS. She will be facing much tougher field!

CALL ME COLE (19.58) broke -1/2 length slow, accelerated nicely (lead) early, +1 length advantage past the gap, drifted in (2-lanes) midway, gradually pulled clear (powerful late run) thru the 9.52 final 1/8 while posting the fastest qualifying time! Prior effort he broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, losing path near the gap, finished out with good energy (behind horses) in the Golden State Million Futurity. STRICTLY THE ONE TO BEAT!!

J FIRE UP (19.68) broke in at the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, finished strong (getting stronger with each and every stride (9.60 final 1/8). Prior effort (19.85) she broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage at the gap, held strong (9.63 final 1/8) when capturing the GOLDEN STATE MILLION. RAZOR SHARP PERFORMER WILL BE SEEKING HIS 6TH CONSECUTIVE WIN!

DITTO HEAD (19.72) bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, put in a big run (lead) past the gap, held strong (9.57 final 1/8). Prior effort he broke -1 1/2 length slow, cut off (losing path) early, dropped back -3 lengths past the gap, FLEW TOO LATE in the GOVERNOR'S CUP FUTURITY. He carries much talent (coming off 4 consecutive troubled trips).

MATILDA CZECH (19.72) broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, put in a big run midway, gained the advantage past the 1/16 pole, gradually pulled clear late (9.55 final 1/8). Prior effort (19.88) she broke -1/2 length slow, accelerated nicely, raced -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.63 final 1/8).

SCOPIE JESS (19.76) bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.62 final 1/8) from the rail. Prior effort (17.69) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, gradually pulled clear vs. MAIDENS. HE IMPROVES HIS POST AND CARRIES TERRIFIC GATE SPEED!

JESS MY KISS (19.78) broke in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, wide path, raced -2 lengths past the gap, kept to his task to the end holding 2nd thru the 9.62 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.57) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, gradually pulled clear late (9.68 final 1/8) from the rail.

PEIGHT YOUR FATE (19.79) broke -1/2 length slow, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.57 final 1/8 vs. DITTO HEAD. Prior effort (19.79) he broke -1 length slow, cut off (losing path) early, -3 lengths past the gap, LEVELED MIDWAY, FLEW TOO LATE (SHOULD HAVE WON EASILY). WATCH OUT IF HE CAN PUT IT ALL TOGETHER.

REMEMER THE ROSE (19.81) broke -1 length slow, -1 length at the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.60 final 1/8) vs. J FIRE UP! Prior effort she swerved in (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, hard to ride to the gap, not abused (toss it out). She improves her post.
