SNITCHING (17.62) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, accelerated nicely, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (not beaten badly for it all) thru the 9.46 final 1/8 vs. GOOD LOOKER. Prior effort (17.74) he broke in at the start, losing - 1 length, -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (just missed) thru the 9.52 final 1/8 over the faster-than-normal racing surface. He is coming off 3 consecutive troubled trips. OUTSIDE POST A REAL PLUS.

OTHERS:

MUCH BETTER REASON (7.89) broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, put in a big run (lead) past the gap, flashed good speed, held gamely (9.76 final 1/8) vs. eventual \$16,00-claiming winner PEDRO CZECH. Prior effort (19.98) he broke out at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end (9.48 final 1/8). 3-back he bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, -3 1/2 lengths midway (toss it out) vs. tougher rivals.

WINNERS COOL CHICK arrives from Wyoming. Sports a winning record (4) and sports a pair of local works. He draws a good post for his 1st start locally and under the lights.

HATEFULIST fractious in gate, broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, caught in tight quarters (bumped repeatedly) early, never had a chance in the Winter Championship trials. Makes his 2nd start with the use of the flipping halter.

BH LISAS BOY broke in at the start, quick to lead, +1 length advantage past the gap, gradually pulled clear (getting stronger with each stride) thru the 9.66 final 1/8. Prior effort (21.48) he broke well, quick in stride, drifted out 6-7 lanes wide near the gap, gamely kept to his task and just missed vs. ZOOMIN FOR SPUDS in the Champion Of Champions! 3-back (19.91) he broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride, held strong (9.59 final 1/8) in the Invitational Championship. 11-time lifetime winner adores the outside post. Note he is undefeated over the 'wet-fast' racing surface (2 for 2). Lots to like for sure!

HE LOOKS HOT (19.97) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced - 1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (clearly 2nd best) vs. BH LISAS BOY. Prior effort (21.34) he broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -3 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (running behind horses) in the Champion Of Champions. 3-back (21.18) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), crushed his field with SPEED TO SPARE. NOTE all 5 of his career wins when he broke sharply!!

ZOOMIN FOR SPUDS (20.07) broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, rallied strong too late (gaining with each and every stride) thru the 9.84 final 1/8 vs. IMA FEARLESS HERO. Prior effort (21.16) he broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in early, raced -3/4 length past the gap, leveled past the 1/16 pole, rallied strong for the score in the Champion Of Champions! 3-back (19.95) he broke in at the start, gained the advantage near the gap, held strong (rail trip). Razor sharp performer needs a perfect trip from the rail slot.

IMA FEARLESS HERO (20.03) bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, +1 length advantage midway, held strong (9.84 final 1/8) vs. earlier Champion Of Champions winner ZOOMIN FOR SPUDS! Prior effort (19.73) he hesitated, broke in at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths at the gap, leveled midway, finished strong in the SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA DERBY (3 year olds). 3-back (19.68) he broke in at the start, losing -1/2 length, right there past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.49 final 1/8) from the rail. He is peaking the right time!

JESS POLLICITICAN (19.94) broke off balance, bumped repeatedly (bumped back/losing path) shortly after the start, raced -3 lengths past the gap, LEVELED TOO LATE vs. IMA FEARLESS HERO. Prior effort (19.93) he bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (running behind horses) in the Southern California Derby. 3-back (19.77) he broke well, quick in stride, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.55 final 1/8. CHECK OUT HIS RATINGS BASED ON ADJUSTED CLOCKING!
