OTHERS:

PERRYS SURFER BOY (19.97) broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, losing path near the gap, crossed inside to clear at the gap, finished out strong (9.59 final 1/8) in the Winter Derby trials vs. top 2 finishers qualified. He will be making only his 2nd start locally and figures to come out a fitter performer.

MIDORI SPARKLE (20.05) swerved out 4-5 lanes shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -3 lengths past the gap, leveled too late over the slower-than-normal racing surface (-1 1/2 length slow). Freshened since 11/20/16. Watch for the improvement factor to kick in.

WELL GOOD (15.69) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (improving his position late) thru the 9.62 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.54) he broke off balance, drifted out, bumped (pushed in) shortly after the start, losing - 1 1/2 length, raced -2 length past the gap, leveled too late (9.80 final 1/8). Throw this one in the mix!

MY SWEET ANGIE (15.55) hit the side of the gate as it opened, swerved out (3-4 lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, leveled midway, rallied strong for her maiden score (9.85 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.69) she broke well, quick in stride, bumped past the gap, -2 lengths midway, kept to her task to the end after losing her best chance.

THE NATURAL NINE broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, shifted out (losing action) early (toss it out). Prior effort (15.66) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.82 final 1/8) when favorably drawn. 3-back he bumped at the start, raced in traffic past the gap, losing path midway.

BK KATMANDU arrives from Wyoming. Formerly trained by R Moosman. Sports a pair of slow works. A toteboard check is advised.

BH LISAS BOY (19.87) broke in at the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, gradually pulled clear late (powerful stride) thru the 9.66 final 1/8. Prior effort (21.48) he broke well, quick in stride, drifted out (6-7 lanes) near the gap, gamely kept to his task and just missed in the Bank of America Challenge Championship. 3-back (21.23) he broke out at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, leveled midway, finished strong too late in the Los Alamitos Invitational Championship. Razor sharp performer adores the outside post and is perfect over a wet-fast racing surface (2 of 2).

HE LOOKS HOT (19.97) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (clearly 2nd best) vs. BH LISAS BOY. Prior effort (21.34) he broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -3 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (running behind horses) in the Champion of Champions! 3-back (21.18) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), crushed his field with SPEED TO SPARE! CHECK OUT HIS 5 WINS (ALL HAVE COME WHEN HE BREAKS ALERTLY).

ZOOMIN FOR SPUDS (20.07) broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, rallied strong too late (gaining with each and every stride) vs. IMA FEARLESS HERO. Prior effort (21.61) he broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in early, -3/4 length past the gap, leveled past the 1/16 pole, rallied strong for the score in the Champion of Champions! 3-back (19.95) he broke in at the start, gained the advantage near the gap, held strong (rail trip). 2016 Champion of Champions winner looms as the one to fear most!
