GIRLS ON FIRE (15.61) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, caught in tight quarters (bumped) past the gap, -3/4 length midway, gamely kept to her task to the end vs. KEEPITINTHECAR. Prior effort (15.49) she broke in at the start, losing 3/4 length, quick in stride, -3/4 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (for 2nd) thru the 9.57 final 1/8. Prior effort she took a bad step midway (toss it out).

LOS PLAN B bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, bumped (knocked off stride/took up) near the wire. Prior effort (15.47) he broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, gained the advantage midway, held strong (9.84 final 1/8) vs. \$10,000-claimers. He must repeat that kind of performance..

FLYING JESS (17.15) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.80 final 1/8) from the rail. Prior effort she was FRACTIOUS in gate, broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, drifted in, bumped repeatedly early, losing path at the gap (toss it out) vs. tougher rivals. 3-back (15.62) she broke off balance at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, lacked the needed response near the wire (9.87 final 1/8) vs. better. Must respect her outside post.

OTHERS:

SECRET SECOND CHANCE bumped at the start, losing -1 length, caught in tight quarters (losing path) midway, not ridden properly thru the final 110 yards vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort (17.00) she broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, drifted in to the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards (rail trip).

HORSES TO WATCH:

BLANK CZCECH (15.64) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -3/4 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (SHOULD HAVE WON) thru the 9.94 final 1/8. Prior effort he was FRACTIOUS at gap, bumped (knocked off stride) shortly after the start, caught in tight quarters (bumped) early, raced -2 lengths past the gap, shuffled back (bumped repeatedly/took up) midway, leveled too late. 3-back (15.71) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held gamely. Check out his improving ratings and may only need a trouble-free journey to get the job done.

ONE MORE CHANCE broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, swerved out (2-lanes) early, not abused (toss it out) vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort he broke -3/4 length slow, drifted in early, raced -3 lengths past the gap, finished out with good energy after losing his best chance in the Two Million trials. 3-back (15.79) he broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, gained the advantage midway, held gamely vs. maidens. Makes his 2nd start with the addition of the blinkers.

SHEZA SPECIAL GIRL (15.74) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held gamely when favorably drawn (9.96 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.68) she broke in at the start, lugged in (2-3 lanes) all the way to the gap, -3/4 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.90 final 1/8). 3-back (15.73) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, drifted in past the 1/16 pole, held gamely vs. easier. She lands a tougher post....

OTHERS:

MAGIC TOSHIKO MAGIC (15.87) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.96 final 1/8) vs. SHEZA SPECIAL GIRL. Prior effort he was FRACTIOUS in gate, swerved in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, drifted in (bumped) at the gap, -1 1/2 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end. He loses J RANGEL.....
