HORSES TO WATCH:

RUNBRORUN broke out at the start, quick in stride (lead), +3 length advantage near the far turn (21.76 opening quarter), crushed his field in powerful fashion (6.23 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke well, sprinted clear (+2 lengths) near the far turn (21.76 opening quarter), losing his advantage entering the stretch, got tired at midstretch (still clearly 2nd best). Claimed from P Aguirre. Love his chances with his sharp form!

RUN RAGING RHINO RUN fractious in gate, lifted at the start, losing -3 lengths, finished out full of run far back after losing his best chance sprinting (330 yards). Prior effort (16.91) he broke well, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to his task and proved best at 330. He worked very well 05/06 and appears the speed of the field!

COWTOWNMARY broke well, dueled outside 2-rivals near the far turn (22.50 opening quarter), battled the length of the stretch and just missed (23.12 final 1/4). He appears the inside speed player!

POP POP'S PIZZA broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-4 lengths), rushed, dueled 2-wide (part of a 4-horse speed duel) near the far turn (22.45 opening quarter), gained the slim advantage at midstretch, held gamely (23.72 final 1/4). Prior effort he broke well, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-5 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (22.61 opening quarter), raced in tight quarters around the far turn, lugged out 5-6 lanes wide entering the stretch.

AIDAN'S HOPE freshened since 09/18/16. Returns with 3-works (gaps between works a concern).

BITZ AND A CHAIR arrives from Golden Gate. Formerly trained by J Thomas. 3 year old is capable of flashing speed. A toteboard check is advised.

HORSES TO WATCH:

AIKAU posted a huge local win 10 races back. He bumped at the start, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-3 lengths), -2 lengths around the far turn (rail), found rail opening mid-final turn, inherited the lead entering the stretch (+1 length), gradually pulled clear late (6.39 final 1/16). Class dropper appears well spotted for his return to Los Alamitos. This race will set up nicely for this late runner!

PARLIAMENTARIAN broke ALERTLY, dueled outside 2-rivals mid-backside, shook loose (+2 lengths) near the far turn (21.75 opening quarter), held gamely (6.34 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke well, -2 lengths early, rushed, dueled inside the eventual winner mid-backside, shook loose (+1 length) near the far turn (21.67 opening quarter), battled the length of the stretch, just missed (rapid 5.37 final 1/16). IF he breaks alertly.....WATCH OUT!!

OTHERS:

AWESOME LEAP broke well, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (22.10 opening quarter), gained the slim advantage entering the stretch, losing lead in deep stretch (6.14 final 1/16). He carries a winning record locally (9-4-3-1).

C R TERROR broke well, dueled 3-wide (part of 5-horse speed duel) mid-backside, raced in tight quarters (took up repeatedly) to the far turn, -3 lengths mid-final turn, gamely kept to his task to the end (22.91 final 1/4). Prior effort he broke off balance at the start, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-8 lengths), traveled evenly down the lane (22.99 final 1/4). Race may set up nicely (check out all the speed signed up).
