HORSES TO WATCH:

COWGIRL N THECITY broke well, dueled between rivals mid-backside, dueled outside one rival near the far turn (22.31 opening quarter), gained the slim advantage at midstretch, held gamely (6.51 final 1/16). Prior effort she broke well, quick in stride, dueled outside 2-rivals mid-backside, dropped back -2 lengths as the pace quickened entering the stretch, gamely kept to her task to the end (6.62 final 1/16). Claimed from R Zuazo. Sharp performer carries options!

SWEET MOMENT broke well, dueled inside one rival mid-backside, battled thru the 22.92 opening quarter, battled the length of the stretch and proved best at 4 furlongs. She will be one of many shooting for the early advantage.

OTHERS:

TEMPETUOUS broke well, dueled 3-wide (part of the 4-horse speed duel) mid-backside, dueled inside the eventual winner around the far turn, dropped back -2 lengths as the pace quickened entering the stretch, gamely kept to her task to the end (24.20 final 1/4). Prior effort she broke well, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside, dropped back -4 lengths as the pace quickened mid-final turn, traveled evenly down the lane (6.50 final 1/16).

REALLY A PRINCESS broke well, dueled inside the eventual winner near the far turn (21.90 opening quarter), dropped back - 2 lengths as the pace quickened entering the stretch, lacked the needed response down the lane (6.51 final 1/16). Prior effort she broke out at the start, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (21.92 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) mid-final turn, losing lead entering the stretch, lacked the needed response down the lane (6.59 final 1/16). She draws a tougher outside post (not likely to see the rail).

JUST A GEM broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-6 lengths), -7 lengths near the far turn (22.04 opening quarter), lugged out 5-6 lanes wide entering the stretch (toss it out). Prior effort she broke well, chased the 4-horse speed duel mid-backside (-4 lengths), -4 lengths near the far turn (21.60 opening quarter), angled out 5-wide entering the stretch, finished out with good energy.

NO GAMES broke well, raced -7 lengths near the far turn (22.04 opening quarter), was carried out 5-6 lanes wide entering the stretch.

***********BEST BET OF THE EVENING********

ANAMONTANA broke well, fanned 6-7 lanes wide mid-backside (-4 lengths) chasing the lone speed runner, put in a good run and challenged 4-wide around the far turn (22.48 opening quarter), battled the length of the stretch and wasn't beaten badly for it all (23.72 final 1/2). Prior effort she broke well, dueled outside 2-rivals near the far turn (22.61 opening quarter), dropped back -2 lengths as the pace quickened mid-final turn, battled back entering the stretch, not beaten badly for it all (23.52 final 1/4). Fresh filly returns with a pair of good works under J Nunez. She carries options for sure!

OTHERS:

CHIEF TIGER coming off a game win over maidens at 5 1/2 furlongs during the daytime racing! He fits well and figures to try this one from off the pace!

REE O KERR broke well, dueled inside one rival mid-backside, shook loose (+2 lengths) near the far turn (21.67 opening quarter), was hard pressed entering the stretch, losing lead at the top of the lane (-1 length), finished out clearly 2nd best at 4 furlongs. Prior effort he broke well, raced 5-6 lanes wide mid-backside (dueling outside 2-rivals). Dropped back -2 lengths past the pace quickened mid-final turn, tired understandably at midstretch.

OPULENCE broke in, bumped back at the start (toss it out). Prior effort she broke in at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, drifted in (3-4 lanes) to the gap, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled too late (thru the rapid 9.62 final 1/8) at 330 yards. She adds the blinkers for the 1st time and will try 870 yards for the 1st time.

TEDDY BREWSKY broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-1 length), -3 lengths near the far turn (22.11 opening quarter), lacked the needed response entering the stretch. Prior effort he broke well, sprinted clear (+4 lengths) mid-backside, DUELED INSIDE 3-RIVALS NEAR THE FAR TURN, battled the length of the stretch, lacked the needed response in deep stretch.

SIZZLIN SASS (15.75) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, losing lead midway, battled back and wasn't beaten badly for it all (9.96 final 1/8). (Q) 05/20 BEST over EFFECTIVENESS (12.1-12.3) Worked inside. Broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 1/2 length advantage midway, never asked, finished out full of run. Winning by +1 length. GRADE: A- DRILL LOOKS LIKE THE ONE TO FEAR MOST BASED IN HUGE WORK PREVIOUSLY!

OTHERS:

THE CARTEL RUNNER (17.74) broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), drifted out (2-3 lanes) past the gap, losing lead midway, gamely kept to her task to the end vs. eventual Ed Burke Million Futurity winner KVN CORONA (17.57). Prior effort (15.70) she broke -1/2 length slow, accelerated nicely, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.88 final 1/8). EXITS THE STRONGER RACES!

SAMBA CORONA MV (15.70) broke out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (holding 2nd) thru the 9.80 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.832) she broke -3/4 length slow, bumped early, raced in tight quarters (bumped) past the gap, kept to her task (running behind horses) thru the 9.90 final 1/8.

STUDIOUS (15.93) broke in at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, close up past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.74 final 1/8). She returns with a "turn and work" of 12.6.

A CAJUN DIVA (15.74) broke off balance at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced in traffic past the gap (-2 lengths), raced behind horses thru the final 1/2. Prior effort she bumped repeatedly (losing path)a past the gap.

ASK THE EAGLE (15.91) broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in early, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, drifted in midway, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 from the rail. Prior effort she broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, drifted out past the gap.

KT TURTLE DOVE (Q) 06/24 worked evenly with HRH BURN BABY BURN (both 12.5) Worked outside. Broke out (2-lanes) at the start, hand shoved, even up midway, never asked, plenty left crossing the wire. Even up. GRADE: B DRILL (Q) 06/06 BEST over HRH BURN BABY BURN (both 12.7) Worked outside. Broke well, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage midway, lugged in (hard to ride) thru the final 1/2 (not ridden properly). Winning by +2 lengths. GRADE: no grade

PRINCESA JOLLYBETH (Q) 06/327 worked solo (12.7) Broke ok, pushed along throughout, responding well. GRADE:A C+ DRILL

RACE 4

HORSES TO WATCH:

TEXAS TORNADOE (15.74) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, wide path, raced -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task and just missed (9.93 final 1/8) vs. easier. She holds the highest ratings based on adjusted clocking and will be making only her 2nd start locally!

ZOOMIN HARD broke off balance, swerved in shortly after the start, raced in traffic past the gap (-2 lengths) in a race to be tossed out. (Q) 06/03 BEST over CERSEI (12.3-12.6) Worked inside. Bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), +2 length advantage midway, responding strong under light pressure. Winning by +3 lengths. GRADE: B+ DRILL HE IS CAPABLE OF TONS BETTTER!

FURVENTS FURY (16.06) broke well, quick in stride (lead), losing lead midway, kept to his task to the end (favorably drawn) thru the 9.98 final 1/8. Prior effort he broke out, bumped at the start, raced in tight quarters (bumped) at the gap, caught in tight quarters (losing path) midway, never recovered. HE POSTED A SOLID "B+ WORK EARLIER (05/06).

SOLIDLY (16.01) broke well, quick in stride, bumped early, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards (exiting night's fastest of 4). Prior effort (16.03) he broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, traveled evenly thru the 110 yards (9.85 final 1/8).

AR SHEZ HOT WIRED broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards. Prior effort (15.77) she broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, kept to hr task to the end (actually just missed 4th). She fits well on the class drop and is capable of a solid rating!

KIDDLE UP MICHAEL (16.00) hesitated slightly, broke in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -3 lengths past the gap, kept to his task to the end vs. tougher rivals. He posted a pair of troubled workouts (04/18 and 04/01).

HORSES TO WATCH:

IMA CHICKS DREAM (17.04) bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to his task (not beaten badly for 3rd) thru the 9.74 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.59) he broke off balance at the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.71 final 1/8). Class wise he is an excellent fit and draws a super post!

TEXAS SNOWMAN (17.09) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held gamely (9.84 final 1/8) vs. easier. Prior effort (REMINGTON PARK) he bumped at the start, quick in stride, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 vs. much tougher rivals. He steps up in class.

CHIC ANN THE WAY and ONE BLEEDING LOVE returns to 300 yards. They got speed sharpened and rates a good chance in this wide open event.

BUILDING WEALTH (15.77) broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in (2-lanes) at the gap, raced -1 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort (16.97) he broke -3/4 length slow, drifted in (2-lanes) at the gap, -1 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end vs. tougher rivals. He fits much better on the class drop.

KICKIN KATELLA (17.09) broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort (15.70) he broke well, quick in stride, never quit trying vs. tougher rivals.

WAVIN BYE BYE CARVER (15.58) broke -1/2 length slow, raced in tight quarters (bumped repeatedly) to the gap, losing path the gap, finished out full of run (behind horses) thru the 9.79 final 1/8 in his comeback!! NOTE HE POSTED A HUGE 'A' WORK EARLIER (03/04). GIVE HIM A STRONGER LOOK FOR SURE!

OTHERS:

BYE THE FIRE (15.54) broke off balance, drifted in, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong vs. troubled field (9.79 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.37) he broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, drifted in, bumped early, -1 length past the gap, raced in tight quarters (bumped) midway, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.57 final 1/8). THE NEXT ONE IN LINE......

BLUEIST (16.74) FRACTIOUS in gate, hesitated at the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted out early, gained the advantage past the gap, held strong (9.69 final 1/8). Prior effort he hesitated, bumped back shortly after the start, losing - 2 lengths, losing path, angled out 3-4 lanes to clear past the gap, finished out with much run left crossing the wire!!

SEVERE CLEAR (16.95) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.71 final 1/8) vs. easier. Prior effort (15.652) she broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, held strong (favorably drawn) thru the 9.80 final 1/8 vs. easier. Razor sharp performer will tested in this tougher spot.

ONE DASHIN MAN(15.62) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.79 final 1/8). Prior effort he broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, raced in tight quarters (bumped repeatedly) midway, never recovered.

DAENERYS (16.99) broke well, quick in stride, raced in tight quarters (bumped) early, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task and wasn't beaten badly for it all (3-way photo). Prior effort she broke -1/2 length, bumped early, raced -1 length past the gap, bumped repeatedly midway, never recovered.

IVE GOT MILK (16.96) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, +1 length advantage past the gap, held gamely (9.767 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.65) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held gamely (9.71 final 1/8) vs. easier.

BF CAPTAIN CAVEMAN (15.56) hesitated, hit the side of the gate as it opened, broke out at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held gamely (9.84 final 1/8) vs. easier. Prior effort (15.63) he broke well, drifted in to the gap (2-lanes), gained the advantage past the gap, held gamely vs. easier.

HORSES TO WATCH:

ATYPICAL (15.49) broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.90 final 1/8) when favorably drawn vs. MAIDENS. Prior effort (15.67) she broke -3/4 length slow, raced -3/4 length past the gap, losing path past the 1/16 pole, gamely kept to her task to the end (rail) in the KINDERGARTEN FUTURITY. Check out her improving ratings!

CARTELS SWEETIE arrives from Idaho when capturing one of the Idaho trials as the bet down favorite (6-5 odds). She is well drawn while making her 1st start under the lights!

KATRINA CARTEL (17.84) broke off balance at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, raced -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (rapid 9.52 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.69) she broke off balance at the start, shifted out past the gap, raced in traffic (bumped/knocked off stride) midway!

SECRETIVE ROMANCE arrives from New Mexico. Filly has been well supported in all of her races. Beat a field of 10 runners 2-back. Formerly trained by T Wood. A toteboard check in advised!

OTHERS:

TRIBAL DASH PRINCESS (15.76) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, drifted in at the gap, losing lead midway, kept to her task to the end (9.84 final 1/8) when competing in night's fastest of 2 races. She will be making 2nd start locally!

LAND OF AHHS broke out (losing momentum) shortly after the start, losing path (toss it out) in the Ed Burke Trials. Prior effort (15.72) she broke out, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -3/4 length, put in a big run (lead) midway, held gamely (9.90 final 1/8). She is coming off 4 consecutive troubled trips.

RACE 8

MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

SUNBEAMSSECRETBEAUTY broke -3/4 length slow, caught in tight quarters (bumped repeatedly) thru the final 1/2, appeared full of run crossing the wire (9.62 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.53) she broke in (2-lanes) at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length at the gap, put in a big run (lead) midway, held strong (9.87 final 1/8). TREMENDOUS FINISHER LANDS THE PERFECT POST TO GET THE JOB DONE!

OTHERS:

KINDA SPICEY (16.93) broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, gradually pulled clear late (9.73 final 1/8) vs. MAIDENS. Prior effort (15.47) she broke well, quick in stride, drifted out (2-lanes) past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.70 final 1/8). Her ratings are getting stronger and appears the next horse in lineup!

RED AND READY (17.03) BROKE THRU THE GATE AS IT OPENED, broke in at the start, quick in stride, flashed good speed, losing lead past the 1/16 pole, kept to her task and just missed 2nd (9.76 final 1/8). Prior effort (16.83) she broke well, quick in stride, drifted in early, right there past the gap, kept to her task to the end (favorably drawn). She must mind her gate manners and draws a tougher inside post.

ACE OF SPAIDS (17.02) bobbled, drifted in shortly after the start, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.68 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.67) she broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, drifted in at the gap, -1 1/2 length past the gap, kept to her task (actually just missed 2nd) thru the 9.74 final 1/2. HIS RECENT RECORD IS MUCH BETTER THAN LOOKED!!

LOUD LITTLED KID broke well, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, shuffled back (losing path) midway (toss it out). Prior effort (15.50) she balked at loading, broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap (drifted in), held gamely (rail trip) vs. maidens. She is blessed with terrific gate speed.....330 yards?

FIRE THE SENATOR arrives from Idaho. She posted ordinary ratings when seen locally earlier.

KTMAKINATAXRETURN hesitated at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, losing path near the gap. Prior effort (16.83) she broke - 1/2 length slow, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.63 final 1/8). She must repeat that kind of effort.
