HORSES TO WATCH:

A LIVIN DYNASTY hesitated, broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 in the Ed Burke Futurity trials. Prior effort he broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start quick in stride (lead), losing lead at the gap, lugged out thru the final 1/2. Note she posted a solid "B+ work earlier (03/30). HE MAKES HIS 1ST START AS GELDING!

BONA FIDE OA (15.83) broke off balance (not quick) from the gap (losing path), raced in tight quarters (bumped) past the 1/16 pole, gamely kept to her task to the end (10.12 final 1/8). Prior effort she broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, finished well (behind horses) thru the 9.84 final 1/8. She is getting closer to victory!

SUMMERTIMES DOLL (15.81) broke -1/2 length slow, raced in tight quarters (bumped repeatedly) midway, raced in tight quarters (bumped) near the wire (10.10 final 1/8). Better is forecast with the race under her belt.

AR SHEZ HOT WIRED (16.24) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced - 1 1/2 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards. Prior effort (15.77) she broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.69 final 1/8) when competing in night's fastest of 5. She needs to repeat that solid rating in her debut!

MY SPECIAL CARTEL broke off balance, not quick at the start (losing path), never quick trying (toss it out). (Q) 05/16 BEST over FIRE IN MY SPIRIT (both 12.5) Worked outside. Broke well, drifted in early, even up midway (asked once), responding well. Winning by a narrow margin. GRADE: B DRILL

OTHERS:

LADYS RED HEELS (16.09) broke -1 1/2 length slow, drifted in (2-lanes) early, -2 lengths past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 (9.90 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.94) she broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end. She improves her post!!

RYTHSM N BLUES GIRL broke out, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing path past the gap. (Q) 05/13 outworked by HIGH MOON RETURNS (12.7-12.6) Worked inside. Broke -1/2 length slow, hand shoved, -1/2 length midway, responding well under light pressure. Losing by -1 length. GRADE: C+ DRILL

RAYDENATOR (Q) 06/06 outworked by PAINT IT SEXY (12.9-12.6) Worked inside. Hesitated, broke in at the start, not quick early, -2 lengths midway, asked repeatedly thru the final 1/2, responding ok. Losing by -3 lengths. GRADE: C-- DRILL

HIT THE BOARD broke in, bumped repeatedly at the start, shuffled back at the gap, never leveled. Prior effort she broke in (2-lanes) at the start, losing -1 length, raced - 1 1/2 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2.

FURVENTS FURY (16.06) broke well, quick in stride (lead), losing lead midway, gamely kept to his task to the end (favorably drawn) thru the 9.98 final 1/8. Prior effort he broke out, bumped at the start, raced in tight quarters (bumped) at the gap, raced in traffic midway (losing path) in a race to be tossed out. He posted a solid "B"+ work earlier (05/06).

FAVORITE KAY (17.94) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, drifted in early, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (sizzling 9.68 final 1/8) in the Ed Burke trials. Prior effort (15.71) she bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 length past the gap, -1 1/2 length midway, shifted out past the 1/16 pole, leveled too late (should have won). He fits well and draws a favorable outside post.

VERIFY THIS CHICK (15.85) broke -1 1/2 length slow, drifted in (2-lanes) early, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, finished out very well (rail trip) thru the 9.94 final 1/8 vs. FURVENTS RURY. Prior effort he hesitated, bumped back (losing path) shortly after the start, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap (toss it out). He improves his post.

FOOSIE LUCY (15.88) broke in at the start, losing -1 length, quick in stride, lugged out (3-4 lanes) midway, raced in tight quarters (bumped) past the 1/16 pole, gamely kept to her task to the end (10.12 final 1/8). Prior effort she broke -1 length slow, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, losing path midway. Improving filly moves away from the rail.

OTHERS:

RUNNIN JESSE (Q) 06/10 BEST over EL ULTIMO BILLETTE (12.5-12.8) Worked inside. Swerved in (4-5 lanes) at the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage midway (asked once left-handed), responding very well. Winning by+2 lengths. GRADE: B DRILL (Q) 05/27 worked evenly with CORONA FIREWORKS (both 12.5) Worked outside. Bumped at the start, hand shoved, -1/2 length midway, responding well under light pressure. Even up. GRADE: B DRILL

JJ TOUGH hesitated, broke in at the start, not quick early, losing action midway (toss it out). (Q) 06/02 worked evenly with JESS BET ME (both 12.2) Worked inside. Hesitated, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, drifted in early, even up midway, asked left handed in spots thru the final 1/2, responding well. Appeared better of the set . GRADE: B DRILL

ROYAL PRIMETIME (16.02) hesitated slightly at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end (9.98 final 1/8). Prior effort he broke well, drifted out at the gap, raced -2 lengths past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2.

HORSES TO WATCH:

SMOKIN CARTEL (15.69) bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, drifted in at the gap, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, lacked the needed response thru the final 110 yards (9.83 final 1/8) when exiting night's fastest of 3. Prior effort (15.74) he broke off balance at the start, quick in stride (lead), drifted out at the gap, swerved in (2-3 lanes) midway, straightened midway, finished strong for the maiden score. He carries improving ratings and draws improves his post.

CORONAS BAR (17.80) broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, drifted in (bumped) past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.68 final 1/8) in the Ed Burke Futurity trials. Prior effort (15.83) he swerved in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced-2 lengths midway, leveled too late (9.84 final 1/8). 3-back (15.88) he broke in at the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, kept to his task to the end. PRICE PLAY?

KING OF APPEALS MV (17.74) swerved out (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, raced-1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.66 final 1/8) vs. eventual Ed Burke Futurity 3rd place finisher CHANCE TO FIRE. Prior effort (15.68) he broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, appeared intimidated midway, shifted in past the 1/16 pole, accelerated too late (SHOULD HAVE WON).
