HORSES TO WATCH:

BARGAINING broke out at the start, dueled inside 2-rivals mid-backside, dropped back -2 lengths as the pace quickened near the far turn (21.76 opening quarter), -4 lengths mid-final turn (rail), gamely kept to his task to the end (6.54 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke out at the start, dueled outside 3-rivals early, chased the dueling pair mid-backside, challenged 3-wide mid-final turn, shook loose (+1 length) at the top of the lane, gradually pulled clear late (6.39 final 1/16) vs. EASIER. He figures to get 1st run at the of GAMBLER'S WISH!

GAMBLER'S WISH broke out, bumped at the start, accelerated to the front at mid-backside (+2 lengths), opened up +5 lengths around the far turn (21.89 opening quarter), crushed with SPEED TO SPARE at 4 furlongs. Prior effort he broke in, bumped at the start, sprinted well clear +6 lengths near the far turn (21.90 opening quarter), +8 length advantage entering the stretch, crushed easier (6.53 final 1/16) vs. soft maidens. STRICTLY THE SPEED OF THE FIELD.

IN CONTROL broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, fanned 4-5 lanes mid-backside (-3 lengths), -3 lengths near the far turn (22.39 opening quarter), closed the gap entering the stretch (-2 lengths back at this point), collared the leader in deep stretch (6.35 final 1/16) vs. productive field (JET SEEKER came back and captured a \$5,000-claiming event in 52.09).

OTHERS:

WARREN'S COLE broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, racing 7-8 lanes wide mid-backside (-8 lengths) chasing the lone speed winner, -10 lengths near the far turn (21.68 opening quarter), 4-wide mid-final turn, 5-wide entering the stretch, rallied too late (6.59 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke -1 length slow, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-12 lengths), -15 lengths near the far turn, 6-wide entering the stretch, lacked a rally down the lane. He improves his post.

UNSTOPPABLESTEVE broke in, bumped at the start, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-6 lengths), -9 lengths near the far turn (22.18 opening quarter), lacked a rally entering the stretch vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort he broke in at the start, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-1 length), dropped back -5 lengths near the far turn (22.43 opening quarter), lacked a rally entering the stretch.

ZIRONDELLE broke well, lagged -12 lengths mid-backside (chasing the lone speed runner), -15 lengths near the far turn (21.50 opening quarter), 3-wide entering the stretch, lacked a rally entering the stretch. Prior effort he broke in, bumped at the start, chased the 4-horse speed duel mid-backside (-12 lengths), -8 lengths near the far turn, traveled evenly down the lane.

HORSES TO WATCH:

BIG G SECRET CRAB broke well, QUICK in stride (hung outside), chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-4 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (21.50 opening quarter), 5-wide entering the stretch, tired understandably at midstretch vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort she broke well, QUICK in stride, dueled outside 3-rivals mid-backside, dropped back -3 lengths as the pace quickened mid-final turn, gamely kept to her task to the end (should have been much closer) vs. tougher rivals. FRESHENED! Formerly trained by D Givens. She is capable of flashing tremendous gate speed from off the bench!
