HORSES TO WATCH:

SHEZA MIGHTY MIRACLE swerved out, bumped back shortly after the start, losing path, finished out full of run after losing her best chance (far back) thru the 9.79 final 1/8 vs. TOUGHER RIVALS. Prior effort (15.58) she bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted in at the gap, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (running behind horses). Class dropper carries the highest ratings (15.58) based on adjusted clocking!

HARLAN COUNTY (17.17) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, leveled midway, finished out with good energy (9.79 final 1/8) running behind horses vs. TOUGHER RIVALS. Prior effort (15.72) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, drifted out (2-3 lanes) midway, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.94 final 1/8). She fits much better on the class drop and improves her post!

OTHERS:

HIGH ON HAREM (15.76) bobbed, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.91 final 1/8) from the rail. Prior effort (17.85) he bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, quick in stride, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (actually just missed 2nd) thru the 9.73 final 1/8. He improves his post and fits well for sure.

A CAJUN DIVA (15.72) broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in at the gap, losing path midway, never quit trying (running behind horses) vs. 4th place finisher HIGH ON HAREM. Prior effort she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, raced in TRAFFIC midway, never cleared.

FIRST TO MULTIPLY hesitated, broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap (toss it out). Prior effort he hesitated at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced in tight quarters past the gap, losing path midway vs. tougher rivals.

AUBVIOUS (Q) 08/15 outworked (12.8-12.7-12.9) Worked outside. Broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, drifted in early, -2 lengths midway (asked once), responding well. Losing by -1 length. GRADE: C+ DRILL

HORSES TO WATCH:

CHECKN SEIS (15.63) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.82 final 1/8). (Q) 09/26 BEST over FAVORITE CHECK (12.3-12.1) Worked outside. Bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), light hand ride, +1/2 length advantage midway, never asked, finished out full of run. Winning by +3/4 length. GRADE: A- DRILL She improves her post and no telling how much faster this filly can go.....

FENIAH FAITH (15.63) broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, held strong (9.90 final 1/8). Prior effort she broke off balance, bumped back shortly after the start, losing path, finished out full of run (behind horses) in her local debut. She improves her post and is headed in the right direction.

QUITE UP (15.52) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -3/4 length past the gap, leveled midway, rallied strong for the maiden score (9.88 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.52) he hesitated at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, drifted out past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.88 final 1/8). He carries a pair of solid ratings based on adjusted clocking!
