MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

LUCKY TOMMY broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-1 length), dueled outside 2-rivals near the far turn (22.35 opening quarter), +2 length advantage entering the stretch, held strong (23.38 final 1/4). Prior effort he bumped at the start, shook loose (+2 lengths) mid-backside, +2 lengths near the far turn (21.79 opening quarter), losing lead at midstretch, never quit trying thru the sizzling 6.08 final 1/16). SHARP THOROUGHBRED APPEARS THE LONE SPEED OF THE FIELD!

OTHERS:

GRACIAS TOM broke out at the start, chased the dueling pair (-4 lengths) mid-backside, -6 lengths near the far turn (21.82 opening quarter), drifted out 4-wide to clear entering the stretch, FLEW FOR THE SCORE (6.47 final 1/16).

CAN'T BEAT L.A. broke out, bumped at the start, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-1 length), -2 lengths near the far turn (23.87 opening quarter), drifted out 4-5 lanes entering the stretch, gamely kept to his task to the end (clearly 3rd best). Prior effort he broke out at the start, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (21.92 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) at the top of the lane, held gamely (6.31 final 1/16).

COULDASHOULDADID broke out, bumped at the start, -3 lengths mid-backside (chasing the lone speed winner), -6 lengths near the far turn (rail), -8 lengths mid-final turn, lacked the needed response down the lane (6.60 final 1/16) vs. YODELER'S WAY. Prior effort he broke well, dueled outside one rival near the far turn (22.34 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) at the top of the lane, held gamely. He must repeat that kind of performance.

COLD BAY off slow (toss it out). Prior effort he broke off balance at the start, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-7 lengths), -9 lengths mid-final turn, finished out with good energy (6.37 final 1/16).

YODELERS WAY broke -1 length slow, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-4 lengths), -3 lengths near the far turn (22.23 opening quarter), 4-wide entering the stretch, gamely kept to his task to the end (6.55 final 1/16). He takes off the blinkers.

HORSES TO WATCH:

SHOW ME BOFUM (20.00) broke out (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, LEVELED TOO LATE (thru the rapid 9.62 final 1/8) at 400 yards. Prior effort (16.83) he bumped at the start, losing -1 length, drifted out, bumped at the gap, -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end at 330. BEEN CRYING TO ROUTE!! WATCH OUT AND FIGURES TO OPEN UP A COMMANDING LEAD TO THE OPENING QUARTER!!

BUCKY GOLDSTEIN broke in at the start, losing -2 lengths, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-7 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (21.92 opening quarter), -3 lengths mid-final turn (3-wide), collared the leader at midstretch, gradually pulled clear late (rapid 6.11 final 1/16). THE ONE TO FEAR THE MOST!

LD IS BACK (19.50) hesitated at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, rallied to the front past the 1/16 pole, gradually pulled clear late (9.54 final 1/8). Posting the fastest qualifying time! Prior effort (19.58) he broke off balance, off slow (losing path) shortly after the start, dropped back -4 lengths past the gap, LEVELED TOO LATE. ONLY NEEDS AN ALERT BEGINNING TO GET THE JOB DONE!

JESS MAS (19.67) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong when favorably drawn (9.62 final 1/8) when posting the 2nd fastest qualifying time! She posted a solid "A" work earlier (09/30). SHE IS BLESSED WITH TERRIFIC GATE SPEED.

TARZANITO (19.63) BROKE -2 LENGTHS SLOW, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (9.62 final 1/8) vs. JESS MAS and company. Prior effort (17.44) he bobbed at the start, losing -1 length, raced -3/4 length past the gap, leveled past the 1/16 pole, rallied strong for the score (9.57 final 1/8). HE PACKS A WICKED LATE KICK but will need an alert beginning!

KISSED BY AN EAGLE (19.73) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -3/4 length past the gap, leveled midway, staged a big finish (9.60 final 1/8) for the score. Prior effort (19.2) he swerved in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.62 final 1/8). 7-time lifetime winner will be flying in the late stage.

THAT RICO (19.76) broke well, quick in stride (lead), drifted out (2-3 lanes) early, flashed good speed, held strong (9.74 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.45) he broke super (lead), flashed good speed, finished strong (hand ride) thru the 9.74 final 1/8. Razor sharp performer is seeking his 6th consecutive win!

RENEWED (19.89) broke well, quick in stride (lead), +3/4 length advantage past the gap, lacked the needed response near the wire (9.60 final 1/8) vs. KISSED BY AN EAGLE. Prior effort (19.96) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed goods speed, losing lead past the 1/16 pole, lacked the needed response near the wire (9.62 final 1/8). His strength is his GATE SPEED.

CHAZAQ (19.69) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, continued strong and just missed vs. JESS MAS and company. Prior effort (17.32) he broke -1 length slow, raced-2 lengths past the gap, finished strong for 2nd (9.52 final 1/8) when favorably drawn.

KATELLA DELI (19.85) broke well, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, shifted out (2-lanes) midway, held strong (9.74 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.54) he broke -1 length slow, accelerated nicely, -1 1/2 length past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 (9.52 final 1/8).

BILLIONAIRE BOY (19.77) broke -3/4 length slow, drifted in early, -1 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end (holding 2nd) thru the 9.74 final 1/8 vs. THAT RICO and company. He posted a solid "B+" work earlier (09/30).

LOOK AT HER (19.81) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, raced - 1 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (just missed 3rd) thru the 9.62 final 1/8) vs. JESS MAS and company. Prior effort she broke off balance, bumped back shortly after the start.
