HORSES TO WATCH:

GETIN GREADY broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-2 lengths), raced -3 lengths near the far turn (22.85 opening quarter), raced in tight quarters (LOSING -2 LENGTHS) entering the stretch, battled back at midstretch, not beaten badly for it all. MAKES HIS 3RD START THE BLINKERS.

EXOTIC OVATION (Golden Gate) broke well, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-3 lengths), closed the gap near the far turn (22.82 opening quarter), dueled between rivals around the far turn, dropped back -2 lengths as the pace quickened mid-final turn, tired understandably at midstretch at 5 furlongs. She took mild betting support in her debut.

WHERE'S HOLLYWOOD broke well, chased the lone speed runner (-7 lengths) mid-backside, -6 lengths around the far turn (2-3 lanes wide), lacked a rally entering the stretch vs. 4th place finisher GETIN GREADY and company. Better is forecast with the local race under his belt.

NICCKY'S SPOT broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-6 lengths), dropped back -11 lengths near the far turn (22.85 opening quarter), lacked a rally entering the stretch vs. 4th place finisher GETIN GREADY. She worked real well prior to his debut.

OTHERS:

SHE'S GONE WESTERN, AUTISMFORTYFIVE and GO NELI GO are 1st time starters and each sports similar works!

HORSES TO WATCH:

LADY OF FIRE broke well, chased the LONE SPEED WINNER mid-backside (-1 length), -1 length near the far turn (22.12 opening quarter), finished out clearly 2nd best (6.50 final 1/16). Prior effort she bumped at the start, chased the LONE SPEED WINNER mid-backside (-1 length), followed the winner's path, finished out clearly 2nd best (6.83 final 1/16). Claimed from A Vallejo. WATCH FOR THIS ONE TO CLEAR THIS FIELD under V Bednar.

RONNIE'S GIRL broke well, racing 5-6 lanes wide mid-backside (dueling outside 3-rivals), dropped back -1 length as the pace quickened mid-final turn, lacked the needed response entering the stretch vs. TOUGHER RIVALS. Prior effort she broke well, chased the LONE SPEED WINNER mid-backside (-2 lengths), -2 lengths around the far turn (21.56 opening quarter), got tired at midstretch vs. TOUGHER RIVALS. SPEEDSTER TAKES OFF THE BLINKERS BUT NEEDS TO CLEAR FROM LADY OF FIRE FOR THE EARLY LEAD.

OTHERS:

WARM LOVE broke well, dueled between rivals mid-backside, dropped back -1 length as the pace quickened near the far turn (22.34 opening quarter), dropped back -3 lengths mid-final turn, drifted out 4-5 lanes entering the stretch (losing her best chance). Prior effort she broke off balance at the start, losing -3 lengths, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-8 lengths), finished out with good energy (6.44 final 1/16). THE LATE FACTOR.
