FLYING JESS (16.99) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.68 final 1/8 from the rail. Prior effort (16.85) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 length, drifted in at the gap, -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (actually just missed 3rd) thru the 9.63 final 1/8 from the rail. She must maintain a straight course!

BLOWN A WAY (16.99) broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, losing lead past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.68 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.53) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), +2 length advantage past the gap, crushed with speed to spare (9.87 final 1/8) vs. easier. She is an excellent fit!

OTHERS:

ALMOST ALWAYS TRUE (100 YARDS) broke well, quick in stride, gamely kept to her task to the end at 100 yards. She got her speed sharpened!

EDDIES JAZZIN (17.10) broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end (favorably drawn) thru the final 110 yards (9.82 final 1/8).

JESS MAS (19.71) broke in at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, drifted in (4-5 lanes) past the gap, continued strong to the end (should have been closer) thru the 9.63 final 1/8 in the Los Alamitos Super Derby (male rivals). Prior effort (19.67) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, drifted in (2-lanes) midway, held strong (favorably drawn). She posted a pair of solid works earlier (09/30 and 09/16). She returns quickly.....

THE FOR JESS (19.69) broke out (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, losing - 1 length, raced -1 1/2 length at the gap, put in a big run midway, continued strong and was just up for the score (9.88 final 1/8). Prior effort (19.62) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.52 final 1/8) from the rail. Razor sharp performer is well drawn.

THERMONUCLEAR ENERGY (21.55) bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, raced -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task and wasn't beaten badly for it all (9.57 final 1/8) vs. tougher male rivals. Prior effort (19.62) she broke -1 1/2 length slow, quick in stride, raced -1 length past the gap, finished strong (SHOULD HAVE WON) thru the 9.88 final 1/8. Tremendous finisher needs an alert beginning.

STRAWFIINDERS JESSEE (16.73) bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, raced -1 length past the gap, put in a big run midway, put in a big run (lead) past the 1/16 pole, gradually pulled clear (9.68 final 1/8). Prior effort (19.66) she bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing - 2 lengths, raced -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.88 final 1/8). One of many in this open event.

MAGGIE DURANT bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 (toss it out). Prior effort (19.59) she broke -1 length slow, quick in stride, shifted in at the gap, leveled midway, finished strong for 2nd (9.52 final 1/8). She must repeat that kind of performance.

APOLLITICAL DASHER (16.81) broke in, bumped (hard) shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), drifted in (2-lanes) past the 1/16 pole (losing lead), kept to her task to the end (9.68 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.48) she broke -3/4 length slow, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to her task (actually improving her position near the wire) thru the 9.82 final 1/8.
