ROCKIN ASTEROID (17.60) swerved in (3-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, leveled at the gap (-1 1/2 length), finished strong (SHOULD HAVE WON) thru the 9.63 final 1/8 from the rail. Prior effort (15.46) he broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start (lead), drifted in (2-3 lanes) to the gap, bumped at the gap, held strong (9.76 final 1/8). He is trouble prone (all 5 of his start). Check out his latest rating based on adjusted clocking. Note he is drawn inside the speedy KVN CORONA!

APOLLITICAL STONE (17.59) broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, drifted in (2-3 lanes) midway, gradually pulled clear late (SPEED TO SPARE) thru the 9.66 final 1/8. Prior effort (17.76) he broke in, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.49 final 1/8). 3-back (17.86) he broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, put in a big run midway, gradually pulled clear late (9.74 final 1/8 (9.74 final 1/8)). WATCH OUT IF HE MAINTAINS A STRAIGHT COURSE!!

THE REVENANT (17.65) broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, quick in stride, gained the advantage midway, held strong (9.55 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.48) he broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, drifted out at the gap, - 1 1/2 length past the gap, straightened midway, finished strong (9.54 final 1/8). He is plenty fast!

HARD HEADED CHICK (17.59) bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 1/2 length past the gap, shifted in at the 1/16 pole, held strong. Prior effort (16.67) she broke off balance at the start, quick in stride (lead), drifted in (2-3 lanes) all the way past the gap, drifted out (4-5 lanes) midway, held strong (9.73 final 1/8). She loses C De Alba.....

WILD WONDER (17.68) broke in at the start, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, held strong (9.63 final 1/8) vs. a troubled ROCKIN ASTEROID. Prior effort (17.83) he broke in, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.68 final 1/8).

JUST WALK BY (17.79) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.76 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.38) she broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), lugged out (4-5 lanes) all the way past the gap, held strong despite lugging out (9.82 final 1/8).

LA RUSA (17.77) broke well, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, held strong (9.71 final 1/8). Prior effort (16.65) she broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, raced in traffic early, cleared at the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (SHOULD HAVE WON).

KING OF APPEALS MV (17.81) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, +1 1/2 length advantage past the gap, gradually pulled clear (9.73 final 1/8) when favorably drawn. Prior effort (16.86) he hit the side of the gate as it opened, broke out at the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage past the gap, held strong (9.76 final 1/8) when favorably drawn.
