### HORSES TO WATCH:

HERE COMES AUTIMS (Los Alamitos daytime) broke well, settled nicely early, raced -4 lengths near the far turn (22.23 opening quarter), -3 lengths entering the stretch, -3 lengths entering the stretch (2-wide), collared the leader at midstretch, gradually pulled clear in deep stretch (52-1 odds winner) at 5 furlongs. He is a better sprinter than a router.

LION'S LUCK (Los Alamitos daytime) bumped back at the start, losing -2 lengths, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-2 lengths), dueled 2-wide (part of a horse speed duel) near the far turn (22.54 opening quarter), battled the length of the stretch, just missed 3rd at 5 1/2 furlongs. Prior effort he broke well, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-5 lengths), -5 lengths around the far turn (21.96 opening quarter), 5-wide entering the stretch, gamely kept to his task and actually just missed 3rd at 5 1/2 furlongs. He fits well.

T'S PLACE broke off balance at the start, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-7 lengths), -8 lengths near the far turn (22.29 opening quarter), 4-wide entering the stretch, finished out with good energy (23.99 final 1/4).

WHO' HOT (Los Alamitos daytime) broke out at the start, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-4 lengths), -5 lengths near the far turn (21.75 opening quarter), lacked the needed response down the lane at 5 furlongs. Prior effort he broke well, quick in stride, dueled outside one rival near the far turn (22.02 opening quarter), battled the length of the stretch, lacked the needed response at midstretch.

### OTHERS:

GRASS RUNNER broke out, bumped at the start, dueled outside 2-rivals near the far turn (21.96 opening quarter), dropped back -2 lengths as the pace quickened entering the stretch, got tired at midstretch vs. 1-5 odds winner! Prior effort he broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-2 lengths), challenged 2-wide mid-final turn, drifted out 4-wide entering the stretch (lead), held gamely vs. maidens.

PROUDTOBESIIILIAN (Los Alamitos daytime) broke well, raced -5 lengths (fanned 4-lanes wide), -5 lengths mid-final turn (4-wide), lacked the needed response entering the stretch at 5 1/2 furlongs. MAKES HIS 1ST START AS A GELDING.

### HORSES TO WATCH:

SANCAS LARGAS (15.60) bumped at the start, losing -2 lengths, drifted in early, raced -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (just missed 3rd) thru the 10.12 final 1/8. Prior effort (16.17) she broke well, quick in stride, bumped at the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (running behind horses). Check out his improving ratings based on adjusted clocking!

DK SHEZ BIGTIME bumped (both sides) shortly after the start, shuffled back (losing path), raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap (toss it out). Prior effort (15.56) she broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (should have been much closer) vs. troubled SANCAS LARGAS. She is capable of much better.
