LOUD LITTLE KID (15.42) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gained the advantage past the 1 1/6 pole, held strong (9.82 final 1/98) vs. EASIER. Prior effort (15.37) she broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in (2-lanes) early, gained the advantage midway, held strong (9.74 final 1/8). Sharp filly will be seeking her 3rd consecutive win!

GOLD DIGGIN QUEEN (20.05) broke -1/2 length slow, lagged-3 lengths past the gap, kept to her task (running behind horses) thru the 9.70 final 1/8. Prior effort she hesitated at the start, losing - 2 lengths in the Adequan California Regional Challenge.

LA DULCE VITA (20.10) broke well, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.55 final 1/8) vs. top 2 finishers qualified for the PCQHRA Derby.

ALL KINDS OF KIND hesitated at the start, losing -3/4 length, caught in tight quarters midway, kept to her task to the end (9.55 final 1/8) vs. top 3 finishers qualified for the Golden State Derby. Prior effort she bumped both sides shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, bumped at the gap, -2 lengths midway, raced in tight quarters (never cleared) in a race to be tossed out.

THE CHARM OF CORONA (19.38) bobbled, drifted out, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, losing -2 1/2 lengths, leveled too late (SHOULD HAVE BEEN RIGHT THERE) vs. HEZA DASHA FIRE. Prior effort (21.07) he broke -2 lengths slow, caught in tight quarters (bumped repeatedly) early, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept this task (SHOULD HAVE WON) thru the 9.54 final 1/8. WATCH FOR THIS ONE TO EXPLODE!!

HEZA DASHA FIRE (19.38) broke off balance at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, +1 1/2 length past the gap, gradually pulled clear (9.46 final 1/8) vs. a much troubled THE CHARM OF CORONA. Prior effort (19.53) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, +3/4 length advantage past the gap, NAILED (tough loss) thru the 9.45 final 1/8 vs. HE LOOKS HOT. 2015 world champion is definitely the one to BEAT.

KATIES EASY MOVES Wyoming shipper posted 3 consecutive daylight wins. He wasn't disgraced when facing eventual Champion of Champions winner ZOOMIN FOR SPUDS last year. 11-time lifetime winner comes here in sharp form!

HE LOOKS HOT (19.58) broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, bumped early, -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (actually just missed 2nd) vs. HEZA DASHA FIRE. Prior effort (19.50) he broke out at the start, raced -3/4 length past the gap, found another gear past the 1/16 pole, rallied strong for the score when favorably drawn.

BIG LEW (19.64) broke off balance, drifted in, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end (not beaten badly for 2nd) vs. HEZA DASHA FIRE and company. He wasn't disgraced in last year's CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS vs. runner-up HEZA DASHA FIRE.

BODACIOUS EAGLE 11-time lifetime winner is having a solid 2017 campaign. He beat BIG LEW 3-back with a late surge for the score at 400 yards.

THERMONUCLEAR ENERGY (19.62) broke -1 1/2 length slow, quick in stride, raced -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task and wasn't beaten badly for it all in the Millie Vessels. Prior effort (16.70) she broke well, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, held strong (9.52 final 1/8) when favorably drawn. MARE WILL BE TACKLING MALE RIVALS!
