HORSES TO WATCH:

VODKA TEXTED YOU broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-6 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (21.86 opening quarter), -9 lengths mid-final turn, rallied too late (6.68 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke well, settled nicely, -5 lengths (chasing the 3-horse speed duel) mid-backside, -6 lengths near the far turn (21.98 opening quarter), rallied too late (23.62 final 1/4). Late runner will be flying the final 1/16.

FOUR GAELS broke out, bumped at the start, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-2 lengths), -2 lengths near the far turn (22.75 opening quarter), closed the gap entering the stretch (-1 length back), battled the length of the stretch, rallied too late (rapid 22.83 final 1/4). He is overdue!

OTHERS:

RUNBRORUN (Los Alamitos daytime) broke well, shook loose (+2 lengths) mid-backside, +2 lengths near the far turn (21.35 opening quarter), was hard pressed at midstretch (losing lead) at 5 furlongs. Prior effort he broke in, bumped at the start, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-2 lengths), dueled outside one rival near the far turn (21.81 opening quarter), gained the slim advantage entering the stretch, losing lead in deep stretch, just missed 2nd.

HOLIDAYINCAMBODIA broke well, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-5 lengths), -7 lengths mid-final turn (3-wide), rallied too late at 4 furlongs. Filly returns with a 3 furlong work on 10/15.

COWTOWNMARY (Los Alamitos daytime) broke well, -4 lengths near the far turn (3-wide), -4 lengths mid-final turn (21.35 opening quarter), -4 lengths entering the stretch, traveled evenly down the lane at 5 furlongs. Prior effort he broke well, dueled outside 2-rivals mid-backside, shook loose (+2 lengths) entering the stretch, gradually pulled clear late (23.62 final 1/4).

ADRIATIC SON bumped at the start, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-1 length), raced -2 lengths near the far turn (22.75 opening quarter), dropped back -8 lengths pace quickened entering the stretch, lacked the needed response down the lane.

HORSES TO WATCH:

PASOBILITY Intermountain arrival posted a pair of much troubled local performances. 5-BACK (17.87) he broke -2 lengths slow, raced in TRAFFIC early, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, drifted in past the gap, leveled too late (far back) thru the 9.74 final 1/8. 6-BACK (15.68) he broke -1/2 length slow, drifted out (2-lanes) early, gained the advantage midway, just missed (tough loss). Formerly trained by D Garfias.

FAVORITE KAY (17.86) broke off balance, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.60 final 1/8) vs. eventual PCQHRA Breeders Futurity winner KVN CORONA. Prior effort (15.65) she bobbed at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway finished every well (9.76 final 1/8).

SPEEDY ELVIS 2-BACK (17.92) bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, bobbed at the gap, drifted past the gap, leveled too late (9.49 final 1/8) in the John Deere California Challenge. 3-BACK (17.88) he broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 length past the gap, losing path past the 1/16 pole, cleared too late. Don't count this one out!
