INDESCRIBALY BLUE broke off balance, pushed in shortly after the start, not abused, finished out full of run. Prior effort (18.07) she bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 (9.55 final 1/8) in the ED BURKE MILLION FUTURITY. She improves her post!!

OTHERS:

UNBLEMISHED (16.84) broke -3/4 length slow, drifted in, bumped early, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.76 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.79) he broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, gained the advantage at the gap, held gamely (9.68 final 1/8). Here's another who is trouble prone (all of his 8 races).

TERRIFIC TEMPTATION (17.75) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, gained the advantage at the gap, held strong (9.69 final 1/8) in the PCQHRA trials. Prior effort (15.75) she broke off balance, bumped back shortly after the start, losing path at the gap, finished out with good energy after losing her best chance.

FAMOUS N HOT (16.90) broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, accelerated nicely, gained the advantage at the gap, held strong (9.76 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.50) she bumped from both sides shortly after the start, bumped at the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end.

MR AMERICAN (15.60) bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, kept to his task to the end (9.87 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.67) he bumped at the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, kept to his task (not beaten badly for it all) thru the 9.87 final 1/8.

TWENTY ONE GUNZ (17.14) broke well, quick in stride, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end (9.60 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.85) he broke in at the start, quick in stride (lead), losing lead past the 1 1/16 pole, kept to his task to the end.

HORSES TO WATCH:

TRES ON FIRST broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, STRANGLLED DOWN thru the final 1/2 (appearing full of run thru the rapid 9.60 final 1/8. (Q) 09/12 BEST (12.4-12.8-12.2) Worked outside Broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, never asked, STRANGLLED DOWN thru the final 1/2 (tons of run left crossing the wire). Winning by +1 length. GRADE: A DRILL (Q) 08/26 STRANGLLED DOWN! GELDING IS MUCH BETTER THAN HIS DEBUT SHOWS! 400 yards a real plus.

SPLENDID CAUSE (15.43) broke -1 1/2 length slow, drifted in (2-lanes) early, SWERVED in at the gap (-2 lengths), leveled midway, finished out strong (should have been much closer) thru the 9.90 final 1/8. (Q) 09/09 worked solo (12.2) Bobbled slightly at the start, quick in stride, flashed good speed, responding strong under light pressure. GRADE: B+ DRILL She improves her post and packs a wicked late kick. 440 yards is ideal.

MATILDA CXECH (17.63) bobbed at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, gradually pulled clear late (9.62 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.67) she broke -1/2 length slow, accelerated nicely, right there past the gap, finished strong (9.68 final 1/8). Razor sharp performer could have easily won her 4 races!

MADAM OF FIRE MV (16.99) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.76 final 1/8). Prior effort (16.71) she broke -3/4 length slow, raced -1 length past the gap, put in a big run midway (lead), held strong (9.62 final 1/8). Filly is seeking her 3rd consecutive win!
