HORSES TO WATCH:

BACK STREET CAT broke well, quick in stride, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-3 lengths), - 3 lengths near the far turn (21.98 opening quarter), dropped back -6 lengths as the pace quickened mid-final turn, traveled evenly down the lane (23.62 final 1/4). Prior effort she broke well, shook loose (+4 lengths) near the far turn, held gamely at 870 yards. THE ONE THEY ALL HAVE TO CATCH!

RONNIE'S GIRL broke well, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (21.82 opening quarter), battled the length of the stretch, lacked the needed response in deep stretch. Prior effort she broke -1 length slow, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-6 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (22.29 opening quarter), lacked a rally down the lane at 870. She acts the part of a good 4 furlong performer!

OTHERS:

FREAKY MONIQUEE broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, lugged out early, racing 5-6 lanes wide mid-backside (-7 lengths) chasing the lone speed winner, 4-wide mid-final turn (-5 lengths), rallied too late (should have been closer) at 870. Prior effort she bumped at the start, drifted in, bumped repeatedly early, chased the dueling leaders mid-backside (-4 lengths), traveled evenly down the lane. She figures for a solid trip!

CUTE TALKER broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-3 lengths), -2 lengths near the far turn (21.92 opening quarter), fanned 4-wide mid-final turn, gamely kept to her task to the end (6.53 final 1/16) vs. easier. Prior effort she stumbled at the start, losing -1 length chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-6 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (fanned 4-5 lanes wide), 4-wide entering the stretch, rallied too late. She wasn't disgraced against better earlier.

DESIGNED FAHSION (Fresno) broke well, dueled inside 2-rivals near the far turn, shook loose (+2 lengths) mid-final turn, losing lead at midstretch, never quit trying at 5 furlongs. Prior effort she broke -1 length slow, +1 length advantage near the far turn (22.35 opening quarter), +3 length advantage entering the stretch, held gamely vs. easier.

VERY THANKFUL broke well, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-2 lengths), -3 lengths near the far turn (21.98 opening quarter), dropped back -6 lengths mid-final turn, lacked the needed response down the lane vs. 3rd place finisher BACK STREET CAT.

WONDERFUL BECKY swerved out (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-2 lengths), -4 lengths near the far turn (22.10 opening quarter), lacked the needed response entering the stretch. Prior effort she broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-1 length), -4 lengths near the far turn (rail), kept to her task to the end (holding 3rd).

HORSES TO WATCH:

WHERE'S BUBBA bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, trailed mid-backside (-8 lengths) chasing the dueling pair, dropped back -14 lengths mid-final turn, rallied too late (6.47 final 1/16). He will be facing more speed in this lineup.

BUCKY GOLDSTEIN (Santa Anita) broke well, shook loose (+1 length) mid-backside, dueled inside one rival around the far turn, dropped back -1 length as the pace quickened mid-final turn, tired understandably at midstretch at 6 1/2 furlongs vs. tougher rivals. Class dropper fits much better and will relish the shorter distance.

POUR ME A CORONA broke -1 1/2 length slow, quick in stride, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.91 final 1/8). He competed in the Wyoming Futurity 2-back.

OTHERS:

ASK THE EAGLE broke off balance, ducked out close to the fence early (toss it out). Prior effort (15.90) he bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.87 final 1/8) from the rail. Trouble prone performer improves her post.

HKB CLASSY CHICK (16.00) broke -1 length slow, bumped early, -2 lengths past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 (running behind horses) thru the 9.77 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.97) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), losing lead at the gap, kept to her task to the end (just missed 3rd).

FIRE IN MY HEART FRACTIOUS in gate, broke -1 length slow, lugged in (3-4 lanes) past the gap (toss it out). Prior effort she broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length slow, raced -2 lengths past the gap, shifted in midway (toss it out). (Q) 09/12 2ND BEST (12.4- 12.8-12.2) Worked inside. Broke off balance, drifted in (4-5 lanes), straightened midway, responding well. Losing by -1 length. GRADE: C+ DRILL

THREE TWENTY broke off balance at the start, losing -3/4 length, lugged in (behind horses) past the gap (toss it out). Prior effort she bobbed, drifted out shortly after the start, raced -2 lengths past the gap, -4 lengths midway (toss it out).

CLEAR THE BASES (Q) 09/30 2ND BEST (12.6-13.5-12.8) Worked outside. Broke off balance, bobbed shortly after the start, - 2 lengths midway, let run, responding ok. Losing by -2 lengths. GRADE: C DRILL (Q) 09/16 outworked (13.2-13.4) worked outside. Broke in, bumped at the start, not quick, -1 length midway, let run, responding ok. Losing by -1 length. GRADE: no grade ((()))

MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

SHAKIN RED WAGON (15.79) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, accelerated nicely, -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (10.12 final 1/8). Prior effort she bumped (pushed in/bumped back) shortly after the start, losing action (toss it out). She holds the highest ratings based on adjusted clocking!

OTHERS:

MR MAJESTIC ROYALTY (15.97) broke -3/4 length slow, wide path, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well (10.02 final 1/8). Prior effort he bumped at the start, losing -2 lengths (losing path). Improving performer broke the magically 16 second barrier based on adjusted clocking.

MELINDAS FURY(16.14) broke out, bumped (both sides) shortly after the start, bumped at the gap, losing midway, traveled evenly thru the final 1/2 after losing her best chance. Much better is forecast with the local race under her belt.

TEXASDESIRE broke -2 lengths slow, losing path at the gap (toss it out) vs. eventual Wild West Futurity finalist L BAR D CLASSIC TRIP. She returns to face non-winners.

SHEZADASHIN CHOICE (16.29) broke well, quick in stride, close up past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 (10.02 final 1/8). Prior effort she broke in at the start, losing- 01 length, losing path past the gap.

HAREMS BEST BET (16.36) broke well, quick in stride (lead), losing lead at the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2 (10.12 final 1/8). (Q) 08/22 outworked by A FANCY DASHER (13.0-12.7) Worked inside. Broke well, quick in stride, hand shoved, drifted in (2-lanes) midway, not used, losing by -2 lengths. GRADE: C DRILL
