SMART SUZZET broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-7 lengths), -12 lengths near the far turn (21.51 opening quarter), traveled evenly down the lane vs. TOUGH RAY. She carries no speed, but will be finishing FAST the final 1/16.

OUR MAERATI broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-5 lengths), -8 lengths near the far turn (21.51 opening quarter), could not keep up turning for home vs. TOUGH RAY and company. Prior effort he broke -1 length slow, dueled 2-wide (part of a 5-horse speed duel) mid-backside, lacked the needed response at midstretch. He will be facing another tough task on the front end.

MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

FAMES FAVORITE (17.00) stumbled in shortly after the start, losing - 1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (actually just missed 2nd) thru the 9.60 final 1/8 when competing in giant clocking! Prior effort (17.89) he bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well for 2nd (9.73 final 1/8). 3-back he broke off balance, bumped repeatedly shortly after the start, was carried out badly (losing path) past the gap. HE POSTED A SOLID 15.66 RATING BASED ON ADJUSTED CLOCKING 4-BACK and drops in for a tag!

OTHERS:

SINGLE N RARE (15.60) broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing - 1 length, raced -1 1/2 length midway, LEVELED TOO LATE (9.91 final 1/8) vs. EASIER. Prior effort he was bumped from both sides shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, losing path at the gap, lugged in (behind horses) midway, not abused, appearing full of run (rapid 9.69 final 1/8). 3-back (15.88) he broke in, bumped at the start, pushed out (losing path) early, finished out with much energy after losing his best chance.

JESS DICEY broke -1 length slow, raced -2 lengths past the gap (behind horses), not good enough thru the final 1/2 (toss it out) vs. solid field. (Q) 10/03 BEST over MISS ZOOMIN LADY (12.3-12.4) Worked inside. Broke off balance, drifted in (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 1/2 length advantage midway (asked once), responding strong. Winning by +1/2 length. GRADE: B+ DRILL He is capable of much better.

TURNER UP (17.27) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well (actually just missed 3rd) thru the 9.60 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.85) he broke well, quick in stride, quick in stride, wide path, raced -3/4 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end. Class dropper fits better.

EAST OF EDEN (15.87) broke in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well (not beaten badly for 2nd) thru the 10.07 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.95) she broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), losing lead past the gap, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2. She improves her post.

KEEP ME WARM (17.19) broke in at the start, quick in stride, wide path, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.77 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.89) she broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, shifted out past the gap, -3 lengths midway, kept to her task to the end (9.94 final 1/8).

MC FIREWALKER bumped back at the start, losing path, drifted out early, raced in TRAFFIC past the 1/16 pole. Prior effort she bumped at the start, drifted in (2-3 lanes) to the gap, losing -1 1/2 length, lacked the needed response thru the final 1/2.
