## RACE 2

(4) LILAC STREET	(5) ROYAL RED	(2) MAGIC CHATTER

### HORSES TO WATCH:

LILAC STREET broke -2 lengths slow, chased the 5-horse speed duel mid-backside (-3 lengths), raced -3 lengths near the far turn (22.53 opening quarter), raced in traffic mid-final turn (-2 lengths), never leveled entering the stretch (toss it out) vs. ROYAL RED and company. She definite last and expect to see a much stronger performance!

ROYAL RED broke well, settled early, chased the 5-horse speed duel mid-backside (-3 lengths), -4 lengths near the far turn (22.53 opening quarter), -2 lengths mid-final turn (rail), rallied to the front at top of the lane, gradually pulled clear (rapid 5.79 final 1/16). STRICTLY THE ONE TO BEAT WITH A REPEAT PERFORMANCE!

### OTHERS:

MAGIC CHATTER broke -2 lengths slow, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-6 lengths), lagged -10 lengths near the far turn (22.46 opening quarter), 5-wide entering the stretch, traveled evenly down the lane after losing her best chance. Prior effort she broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-5 lengths), raced -8 lengths near the far turn (21.98 opening quarter), 4-wide entering the stretch, finished out with good energy.

CODE ALERT broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-2 lengths), -2 lengths near the far turn (22.25 opening quarter), challenged inside one rival entering the stretch, gained the narrow advantage at top of the lane, held gamely (6.33 final 1/16). Prior effort she swerved in at the start, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (22.81 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) entering the stretch, held gamely (6.40 final 1/16).

WIRED FOR FUN freshened since 10/14/16. Sports a series of good works under J Nunez. Worth a strong look at the betting board!

## RACE 3

(7) RUNNIN JESSE	(9) BOYS ARE BEST	(6) OAK RANCH

### HORSES TO WATCH:

RUNNIN JESSE (15.68) broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (should have been closer) thru the 9.90 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.79) he broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, lugged in midway, gamely kept to his task to the end. Check out his improving ratings based on adjusted clocking.

BOYS ARE BEST broke in (losing path) shortly after the start, raced -3 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (9.90 final 1/8) in a race to be tossed out. Prior effort (15.80) he broke out, bumped (hard) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to his task to the end. He is coming consecutive troubled trips!

OAK RANCH hesitated, hit the side of the gate as it opened, swerved in, bumped repeatedly (hard) shortly after the start, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, not abused, finished out with run left crossing the wire after losing his best chance. (Q) 07/15 outworked by CALIFORNIA BLOSSOM (12.2-12.3) Worked outside. Broke well, drifted in early, -1/2 length midway, pushed along, responding very well. GRADE: B DRILL

A CAJUN DIVA (15.83) swerved in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, caught in tight quarters (shuffled back/losing path) past the gap, leveled too late (still improving her position late) thru the 9.98 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.80) she broke in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, kept to her task to the end (running behind horses) thru the 9.94 final 1/8. She much better than her record shows!
