HORSES TO WATCH:

MULTIPLE SUNS broke well, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-11 lengths), dropped back -14 lengths near the far turn (22.34 opening quarter), angled out 4-5 lanes to clear entering the stretch, finished out with good energy (solid 23.69 final 1/4) vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort he broke well, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-6 lengths), -7 lengths near the far turn (23.23 opening quarter), angled out 4-5 lanes to clear entering the stretch, rallied strongly too late (improving his position). Class dropper definitely got his speed sharpened in last pair and gets his best chance.

GAME PIECE broke well, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-3 lengths), -2 lengths near the far turn (22.48 opening quarter), 4-wide entering the stretch, lacked the needed response thru the lane (6.10 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke well, raced -2 lengths near the far turn (22.1 opening quarter), challenged outside one rival mid-final turn, assumed command (+3 lengths) entering the stretch, lacked the needed response at midstretch, finished out clearly 2nd best. WATCH FOR SPEED FROM HIS INSIDE DRAW.

GRASS RUNNER broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-6 lengths), -7 lengths near the far turn (22.20 opening quarter), gamely kept to his task to the end (6.15 final 1/16). Prior effort he bumped at the start, chased the lone speed winner throughout, kept to his task to the end (23.38 final 1/4). Not without a chance with a clean trip.

SECERTARY GENERAL broke out at the start, dueled outside 2-rivals mid-backside, dueled outside the eventual winner near the far turn (22.35 opening quarter), drifted out 4-wide entering the stretch, traveled evenly down the lane (rapid 5.77 final 1/16). Prior effort he bumped back at the start, losing -2 lengths, lagged -16 lengths near the far turn (22.13 opening quarter), racing 4-5 lanes wide mid-final turn, 5-6 lanes entering the stretch, finished out with good energy (6.70 final 1/16). He may find himself on the front end!

MISTER FANCY BEAN broke well, settled, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-2 lengths), -5 lengths near the far turn (22.20 opening quarter), 4-wide to clear entering the stretch, finished out with good energy (just missed 2nd) thru the 6.15 final 1/16.

HORSES TO WATCH:

RENEGADE RUN broke - 1 length slow, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-2 lengths), -3 lengths near the far turn (21.95 opening quarter), -4 lengths entering the stretch, gamely kept to her task to the end (holding 2nd) thru the rapid 5.87 final 1/16. Prior effort she broke well, raced -3 lengths near the far turn (21.71 opening quarter), followed the winner's path down the lane (clearly 2nd best).

SHE HUMS bumped at the start, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-4 lengths), -3 lengths near the far turn (21.92 opening quarter), -1 lengths entering the stretch (4-wide), inherited the lead in deep stretch (6.58 final 1/16). Prior effort she broke well, dueled inside one rival near the far turn, dropped back -1 length as the pace quickened near the far turn, dropped back -5 lengths entering the stretch, tired understandably at midstretch vs. tougher rivals. Claimed from F Gonzalez.

SMART SUZZET broke well, dueled inside 2-rivals mid-backside, dropped back -4 lengths as the pace quickened near the far turn (22.17 opening quarter), angled out 4-wide to clear entering the stretch, rallied too late (6.20 final 1/16). Prior effort she broke well, settled, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-7 lengths), -11 lengths near the far turn (21.92 opening quarter), avoiding the accident at midstretch, finished out clearly (rapid 5.58 final 1/16). She is racing in good form!

OTHERS:

HERE COMES BOBBIE broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-4 lengths), raced -7 lengths near the far turn (21.95 opening quarter), drifted out 5-lanes entering the stretch, lacked a rally down the lane vs. RENEGADE RUN and company. Prior effort she broke well, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-3 lengths), -4 lengths near the far turn (22.92 opening quarter), traveled evenly down the lane.

SKYE NOVA broke out, bumped at the start, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-10 lengths), -14 lengths near the far turn (21.95 opening quarter), finished out with good energy (5.87 final 1/16). Prior effort she broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, dropped back -13 lengths near the far turn, lacked a rally entering the stretch.

TWENTY FOUR BLACK broke well, lagged -14 lengths near the far turn 21.93 opening quarter), traveled evenly down the lane.

MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

STATELY COMMAND swerved out (3-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride, could not clear early, racing 5-6 lanes wide mid-backside (-4 lanes) chasing the dueling pair, raced 4-lanes wide near the far turn (22.01 opening quarter), 5-6 lanes wide entering the stretch, finished out with good energy after her wide journey vs. TOUGHER RIVALS. She improves her post and will receive tons of speed to rundown in this event! BIG PRICE PLAY!

EVENING AGAIN broke well, sprinted clear (+2 lengths) mid-backside, +3 lengths near the far turn (22.07 opening quarter), +4 lengths entering the stretch, held strong (24.07 final 1/4) at 870 yards. She is racing in sharp form and definitely got her speed sharpened in last. SPEED OF THE SPEED PLAYERS?

SWEET MOMENT bumped at the start, could not clear, fanned 5-6 lanes mid-backside (-4 lengths), 4-wide to the far turn (22.43 opening quarter), LUGGED OUT TURNING FOR HOME in a race to be tossed out vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort she broke well, dueled 3-wide (part of 4-horse speed duel) mid-backside, shook loose +3 lengths entering the stretch, gradually pulled clear at 4 furlongs. Here's another class dropper that carries plenty of speed!

VERY THANKFUL broke well, +1 length advantage mid-backside, opened up +3 lengths near the far turn (21.95 opening quarter), +4 lengths entering the stretch, gradually pulled clear (rapid 5.87 final 1/16) vs. easier. Prior effort she broke well, opened up +3 lengths near the far turn (21.71 opening quarter), held strong at 4 furlongs. She will be facing a field loaded with speed players but her sharp form is a plus!

LOVE PHONE bumped at the start, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-5 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (21.95 opening quarter), traveled evenly down the lane (5.87 final 1/16) vs. VERY THANKFUL.

MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

CAN'T BEAT L.A. broke off balance, bumped back at the start, LOSING -3 LENGTHS, accelerated nicely. Dueled inside 3-rivals mid-backside, battled thru the 22.01 opening quarter, dropped back -2 lengths as the pace quickened entering the stretch, never quit trying after losing his best chance at the start! Prior effort he broke -2 LENGTHS SLOW, -3 lengths early, put in a big run (lead) mid- backside, shook loose (+4 lengths) entering the stretch, held strong (6.67 final 1/16). STRICTLY THE ONE TO BEAT WITH AN ALERT BEGINNING!

OTHERS:

FANCY TERRACE broke out, bumped at the start, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (22.23 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) at the top of the lane, gradually pulled clear late vs. easier. Prior effort he broke well, +2 length advantage near the far turn (22.01 opening quarter), +3 length advantage entering the stretch, lacked the needed response in deep stretch (6.16 final 1/16). SHE CARRIES OPTIONS!

YODELERS WAY broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-7 lengths), -7 lengths near the far turn (22.21 opening quarter), saved ground, CLEARED AT MIDSTRETCH, rallied too late (6.67 final 1/16). Check out all the speed signed up.

ALL MAGIC broke out at the start, dueled between rivals near the far turn (22.01 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) mid-final turn, drifted out 3-wide entering the stretch, losing lead at midstretch, kept to his task to the end (5.94 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke well, racing 6-7 lanes wide mid-backside (-2 lengths) chasing the 3-horse speed duel, lacked the needed response down the lane. Not impossible with the right kind of trip.

MR. ARAIZA broke well, chased the 4-horse speed duel mid-backside (-10 lengths) chasing the 4-horse speed duel, -12 lengths near the far turn (22.01 opening quarter), lacked a rally entering the stretch.

GREAT BAMBINO just got thru beating a soft maiden field (6.41 final 1/16). He will be facing more speed and multiple winners for the 1st time.

HORSES TO WATCH:

A FANCY DASHER arrives from Idaho. (Q) 08/08 BEST over A FANCY DASHET (both 13.1) Worked inside. Moving as the gates opened, broke off balance, drifted in (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, hand shoved for speed, leveled midway, finished out very well under light pressure. Winning by a narrow margin. GRADE: C+ DRILL note missed work on 08/22. Can win based on good work on 08/08!

EL ULTIMO BILLETE (15.89) broke off balance at the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (9.87 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.78) he broke off balance, bumped back at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late. 3-back he clipped heels past the 1/16 pole. LOOKS TOUGH TO BEAT WITH A CLEAN JOURNEY.

OTHERS:

CORONA COMA (15.870 bumped (pushed out 3-4 lanes) shortly after the start, dropped back -5 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished out very well (should have been much closer) vs. maiden \$8,000-claimers. Prior effort (17.37) he broke in (2-lanes) at the start, quick in stride (lead), losing lead past the gap, drifted out (2-lanes) midway, kept to his task to the end. He encountered trouble in all of his 5-outings.

MISS GRANITE BELL (15.91) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, raced - 1 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end when favorably drawn (9.96 final 1/8). Prior effort she bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 1/2 lengths at the gap, losing path midway.

ONE OF A KIND (Q) 08/15 BEST (12.8-12.7-12.9) Worked in the middle. Hesitated, broke off balance at the start, losing -1/2 length, hand shoved for speed, -1 length midway, responding strong under light pressure. Winning by +1/2 length. GRADE: C+ DRILL (Q) 08/05 BEST (both 12.9) Worked outside. Hesitated, drifted out (3-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, -2 lengths midway, let run thru the final 1/2, responding well. Winning by a narrow margin. GRADE: C+ DRILL

SADIES JETT broke -2 lengths slow, drifted out early, raced in traffic thru the final 110 yards (9.93 final 1/8). Prior effort she hesitated, cut off shortly after the start (losing action).

HORSES TO WATCH:

CASONS DREAM broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, losing-1 length, raced -3 1/2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (not beaten badly for 2nd) thru the 9.94 final 1/8. Prior effort she stumbled at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished well (running behind horses). (Q) 08/12 worked solo (18.1) no blinkers. Broke off balance, drifted in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride, light hand ride, asked once midway, asked twice past the 1/16 pole, responding strong. GRADE: B+ DRILL TAKES OFF THE BLINKERS!

BOXCAR WILLI (15.65) broke in at the start, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.88 final 1/8) vs. maidens. He sports a solid rating but will be facing winners for the 1st time.

DIVIDEMEUP (15.80) broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, finished strongly and just missed (9.95 final 1/8) vs. easier. Prior effort (15.54) bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted out early, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (9.91 final 1/8). Check this out....she has now encountered trouble in her last 10 outings!

OTHERS:

VALENTIN CZECH (17.93) bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, gamely kept to his task and just missed (tough loss) thru the 9.73 final 1/8.

MONGOOSE FOOSE (18.04) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, losing lead past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (not beaten badly for it all) thru the 9.73 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.56) he broke -3/4 length slow, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well for 3red (9.84 final 1/8).

HORSES TO WATCH:

DA ONE TWO SPECIAL (16.75) broke out, bumped repeatedly all the way to the gap, losing -1 1/2 length, leveled past the gap, big run (lead) midway, gradually pulled clear late (9.65 final 1/8) vs. MAIDENS. (Q) 06/20 BEST over ZIGGY SOUND (12.2-12.0) Worked outside. Broke well, quick in stride (lead), drifted out (2-lanes) early, +2 length advantage midway, staged a big finish under light pressure. Winning by +3 lengths. GRADE: A DRILL LIGHTLY RACED PERFORMER CARRIES MUCH HIDDEN ABILITY!

JOUET WITH FIRE (19.71) hesitated, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, caught in tight quarters (shuffled back/losing path) midway, appeared full of run crossing the wire in the Winter Derby. Prior effort (19.44) broke off balance at the start, losing - 1 1/2 length, raced in tight quarters early, leveled midway, finished strongly (SHOULD HAVE WON). Trouble prone performer is capable of powerful ratings!

BOS ON TIME broke in (3-lanes) at the start, losing -2 lengths, losing path at the gap, not abused (toss it out) vs. eventual Golden State Derby winner THAT RICO (19.71 winner). Prior effort he broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, drifted in (2-3 lanes) past the gap, never cleared (toss it out). He is well drawn.

ODESEUS (15.53) broke -3/4 length slow, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task and actually improved his position near the wire (9.85 final 1/8). He will be making only his 2nd start since 04/22.

ONE HOT DIAL (15.60) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, losing lead midway, gamely kept to his task to the end (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.79 final 1/8. Makes 2nd start under A Aceves.

FLYINGS JESS broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, drifted in, bumped repeatedly early, losing path near the gap (toss it out) in the Bank Of America California Regional Challenge. Prior effort (16.99) she broke in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride, close up past the gap, kept to her task to the end (rail trip).

PURSE: \$25,000-DISTANCE: 350 YARDS

BANNISTER (19.67) broke -1 length slow, lugged out (4-5 lanes) all the way to the gap, lugged out (2-3 lanes) midway, LEVELED TOO LATE (9.63 final 1/8). Prior effort (19.82) he broke -3/4 length slow, quick in stride, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.46 final 1/8) from the rail. 8-time lifetime winner will be tough to beat if he puts it all together.

TARZANITO (19.91) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, finished strong and was just up for the score in the Two Million trials. Prior effort (19.52) he broke off balance at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (improving his position) thru the 9.49 final 1/8. Fresh and extremely dangerous from off the bench.

WELL GOOD (19.84) hesitated, broke out (2-lanes) at the start, losing - 1 1/2 length, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, finished out with good energy after losing his best chance at 400. Prior effort (16.82) he bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.62 final 1/8). He draws a favorable outside post.

HOOSE COOSE (27.23) broke out, bumped at the start, quick in stride, +2 length advantage past the gap, held strong (10.24 final 1/8) at 550 yards. Prior effort (17.58) he broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, shifted in at the gap, leveled past the 1/6 pole, finished strong for the score (9.63 final 1/8). Razor sharp performer gets tested.

OTHERS:

THATS IMPERIAL (16.69) broke -1 length slow, raced -2 1/2 length past the gap, leveled too late (9.52 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.55) he broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong (9.82 final 1/8) when favorably drawn.

KATELLI DELI (19.83) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, gained the advantage midway, just missed (tough loss) thru the 9.63 final 1/8 in the Governor's Cup Derby. Prior effort (19.86) he bumped at the start, losing - 3/4 length, quick in stride, close up past the gap, kept to his task to the end (9.63 final 1/8).

THREEMAKESONE (15.41) broke -3/4 length slow, quick in stride, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, rallied strong for the score vs. easier.
