HORSES TO WATCH:

SUNRISE LEGACY broke well, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-2 lengths), dueled outside 2-rivals near the far turn (22.36 opening quarter), dueled outside one rival mid-final turn, shook loose (+1 length) entering the stretch, held gamely at 4 furlongs. Prior effort he broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, dueled outside 2-rivals near the far turn (22.15 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) at the top of the lane, held gamely (6.33 final 1/16). Versatile and extremely sharp!

GRUMPY SMALL MOUTH broke -1 length slow, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-4 lengths), -4 lengths near the far turn (22.09 opening quarter), -3 lengths mid-final turn, angled out 4-wide to clear entering the stretch, lacked the needed response in deep stretch (23.27 final 1/4) vs. TOUGHER RIVALS. Prior effort he bumped at the start, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (21.79 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) mid-final turn, held gamely (6.47 final 1/16). HE RETURNS TO HIS WINNING CLASS LEVEL!

OTHERS:

ANYTHINGTOGETEVEN broke well, dueled 2-wide (part of a 4-horse speed duel) mid-backside, dropped back -2 lengths near the far turn (21.82 opening quarter), -3 lengths mid-final turn, kept to his task to the end (6.34 final 1/16). FRESHENED SINCE 05/21. A private purchase from J Nunez.

FANCY TERRACE flashed brief speed when facing a restricted \$3,200-claiming event. Prior effort he broke out, bumped at the start, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (22.23 opening quarter), shook loose (+1 length) at the top of the lane, gradually pulled clear late (6.41 final 1/16). HE RETURNS QUICKLY but returns to his winning class level.

MAXIMUM MAXIMUM broke well, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-7 lengths), -7 lengths near the far turn (21.31 opening quarter), traveled evenly down the lane (6.51 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke well, dueled outside 2-rivals mid-backside, dueled outside on rival near the far turn (21.86 opening quarter), gained the slim advantage mid-final turn, losing lead at the top of the lane, finished out clearly 3rd best.

REE O KERR broke well, dueled inside the eventual winner mid-backside, dueled thru the 21.85 opening quarter, dropped back -5 lengths as the pace quickened entering the stretch, tired understandably at midstretch (6.47 final 1/16).

VICTORIOUSLY JEWEL arrives from the Fair Circuit. Hails from connections that fare well with these types. A toteboard check is advised.

HORSES TO WATCH:

CROWDED WAY broke out, bumped back shortly after the start, losing -3 lengths, trailed mid-backside (-6 lengths) chasing the 3-horse speed duel, raced -7 lengths near the far turn (22.40 opening quarter), RALLIED TOO LATE (should have been much closer) at 4 furlongs. Prior effort she broke well, chased the lone speed winner, lacked a rally entering the stretch vs. TOUGHER MALE RIVALS. IMPROVES HER POST AND FIGURES FOR A SOLID GROUND SAVING TRIP!

COWGIRL N THECITY broke in, bumped at the start, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-4 lengths), -4 lengths near the far turn (22.40 opening quarter), -4 lengths mid-final turn, traveled evenly down the lane at 4 furlongs. Prior effort she broke well, dueled 2-wide (part of a 4-horse speed duel) mid-backside, settled -2 lengths near the far turn (22.3 opening quarter), gained the slim advantage mid-final turn, held gamely (6.51 final 1/16). She is racing in good form.

YANQUE bumped at the start, losing -1 length, bumped past the gap, bumped back (losing path) midway (losing action) in the Governor's Cup Futurity. Prior effort (17.67) he broke in at the start, losing -1/2 length, put in a big run (lead) past the gap, flashed good speed, held strong in the Governor's Cup trials. The one to beat with a repeat performance!!

HIGHER ICON (15.64) broke in at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (should have been much closer) thru the 9.87 final 1/8 in his local debut! HE IMPROVES HIS POST!!

OTHERS:

MR SOUL broke well, quick in stride, swerved out, bumped early, raced -2 lengths past the gap, STRANGLED DOWN thru the final 1/2. Prior effort he broke in at the start, losing -1 length, raced - 1 1/2 length past the gap, shifted out (in traffic) midway, never quit trying thru the 9.73 final 1/8. He is coming off consecutive troubled trips.

R STURDY BOY broke off balance, bumped back (losing path) shortly after the start, raced -2 1/2 length past the gap, leveled too late (thru the sizzling 9.49 final 1/8) in the John Deere Juvenile California Regional Challenge. Prior effort (17.87) he bumped at the start, losing -1 length, drifted in at the gap, -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled too late. He is capable of much better!

COWGIRL N UP (18.00) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished very well (9.84 final 1/8) her local debut. She posted a pair of sharp wins at Turf Paradise earlier.

THE BOSSGIRL/DYNASTY DARLIN/RECKING BALL/KRASH YOUR PARTY all are considered major factor based on consistent ratings.
