CALIFORNIA BLOSSOM (15.56) broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced-1 1/2 length past the gap, -2 lengths midway, leveled too late(9.84 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.59) she swerved out (3-4 lanes) shortly after the start, losing-1 1/2 length, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, finished out full of run after losing her best chance (9.94 final 1/8). She produced a pair of 'green' works prior to her debut. She holds a pair of solid ratings based on adjusted clocking!

JAZZY ICON (15.61) broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, drifted in early, quick in stride, -1 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.77 final 1/8) from the rail. Prior effort (15.70) he broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, losing-2 lengths, raced -3 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (9.90 final 1/8). HE HOLDS IMPROVING RATINGS BASED ON ADJUSTED CLOCKING.

FOOSE JENNER (15.57) swerved in, bumped at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.87 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.62) he broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -2 1/2 lengths past the gap, not abused, finished out with run left crossing the wire (9.84 final 1/8). HE HOLDS THE HIGHEST RATINGS BASED ON ADJUSTED CLOCKING but must flee the rail tonight.

TELL THEM IM THEONE (Q) 08/12 BEST over HOLLYWOOD CARTEL (13.1-12.8) Worked outside. Broke well, quick in stride (lead), drifted out early, +2 length advantage midway, never asked, responding strong under light pressure. Winning by +4 lengths. GRADE: B DRILL Note missed work on 08/26.

OTHERS:

STUDIOUS hesitated at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, drifted in early, -2 lengths past the gap, raced in tight quarters (steadied back/losing path) midway, not abused (toss it out). Prior effort (16.05) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), losing lead past the 1/16 pole, kept to her task to the end (10.07 final 1/8).

DUAL CARTEL (17.17) broke well, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage at the gap, drifted in (3-4 lanes) midway, losing lead past the 1/16 pole, kept to his task to the end (holding 2nd) thru the 9.77 final 1/8. Prior effort he hesitated at the start, losing -3 lengths, drifted in at the gap (toss it out).

CRYSTIS LUCK (17.14) broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well (improving her position) thru the 9.77 final 1/8. Prior effort she bumped back at the start (losing path), not abused (toss it out).

SIXMARTINI BREAKFAST broke in at the start, bumped early, drifted out (2-lanes) midway (toss it out). He lugged in both works prior.

HORSES TO WATCH:

TR HITT N RUN (Santa Rosa) swerved out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride, right there midway, gamely kept to his task to the end (clearly 3rd best) vs. tougher rivals. Prior effort (Pleasanton) he broke off balance at the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted in (bumped/knocked off stride) early, losing path midway, cleared thru the final 110 yards, finished out full of run (should have been much closer). He competed against much better locally last year!

QUIK ALIBI (15.81) broke in at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (just missed 3rd) from the rail. (Q) 07/15 outworked by FIRST AND FINAL (17.8-18.8) Worked outside. Broke out (3-4 lanes) shortly after the start, not quick, -6 lengths past the gap, not abused, finished out good energy. Losing by -10 lengths. GRADE: C+ DRILL IMPROVES HER POST!

COLIMENCE (15.78) broke out at the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task (holding 2nd) thru the 9.88 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.90) she swerved in, bumped at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end and just missed (10.02 final 1/8). Her ratings are improving based on adjusted clocking.

OTHERS:

SCARFACE ONE (15.92) broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, gamely kept to his task and wasn't beaten badly for it all (10.02 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.85) he broke off balance, bobbed shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, losing path past the gap, cleared midway, finished out with good energy (10.01 final 1/8).

OUGHT TO BE WANTED (Q) 06/10 worked solo (18.5) Broke in at the start, quick in stride, hand shoved for speed, pushed along, responding very well. GRADE: B DRILL

SPLASH OF FORTUNA (Q) 09/02 worked solo (18.5) broke out at the start, hand shoved for speed, pushed along throughout, responding well. GRADE: B DRILL (Q) 07/01 BEST (19.2-18.6-18.6) worked outside. Broke well, hand shoved for speed, drifted in early, flashed good speed, even up midway, never asked, responding well, Winning by a narrow margin. GRADE: C+ DRILL

HORSES TO WATCH:

ONE TEMPTING CHICK (Q) 08/19 BEST over FAVOR IT (12.5-12.3) Worked outside. Broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride, light hand ride, +1/2 length advantage midway, never asked, getting stronger with each stride. Winning by +2 lengths. GRADE: B+ DRILL (Q) 07/22 BEST (13.3-no time) Swerved in (3-lanes) at the start, STRANGLED DOWN. GRADE: no grade

BETTER THAN EVER (15.60) broke in (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, close up past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.77 final 1/8). (Q) 08/12 worked evenly with STRIVEN (both 12.3) Worked inside. Broke off balance, bumped, pushed in (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, hand shoved for speed, even up midway, responding well. Even up. GRADE: B DRILL FILLY HOLDS THE HIGHEST RATINGS BASED ON ADJUSTED CLOCKING!

OTHERS:

DF APOLLITICAL SIGN (15.78) broke off balance at the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (just missed 2nd) thru the 9.88 final 1/8. Prior effort (15.61) she broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, gamely kept to her task to the end (holding 3rd) thru the 9.79 final 1/8. Not without a chance with an alert beginning.

KEEP ME WARM (15.89) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, shifted out past the gap, -3 lengths midway, kept to her task to the end (9.94 final 1/8). (Q) 07/18 outworked by QUITE UP (12.6-12.5) Broke ok, drifted in early, even up midway, asked repeatedly thru the final 1/2, responding ok. Losing by a narrow margin. GRADE: C+ DRILL

HIGH PLAINS SKY (Q) 08/26 worked evenly with EAGLES POLICY (both 12.3) Worked inside. Broke in (2-3 lanes) at the start, quick in stride, hand shoved, -1/2 length midway, asked once thru the final 1/2, responding very well. Even up. GRADE: B DRILL (Q) 08/12 worked evenly with EAGLES POLICY (both 12.6) Worked outside. Broke off balance, drifted out (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, not quick in early, -2 lengths midway, let run, responding well. Even up. GRADE: B DRILL
