OTHERS:

MISSMERIZING (17.73) broke off balance at the start, quick in stride (lead), losing lead at the gap, drifted in (2-3 lanes) midway, not ridden properly thru the 9.49 final 1/8. Prior effort (17.92) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, just missed (tough loss) thru the 9.80 final 1/8.

GERBERA GLASS (15.64) broke -1 length slow, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong for 3rd (9.74 final 1/8). Prior effort she stumbled badly (bumped back) shortly after the start, raced in traffic at the gap (losing path), not abused.

DOCS LAST CARD (15.57) hesitated, swerved out (3-lanes) shortly after the start, losing -1 1/2 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, floated out midway, gamely kept to her task to the end (9.84 final 1/8). (Q) 08/19 outworked (12.4-12.6-12.2) Worked inside. Broke well, quick in stride, hand shove, even up midway, let run, responding well. Losing by -1/2 length.

HORSES TO WATCH:

EFFORTLESS EFFORT broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, caught in tight quarters (bumped) past the gap, raced in traffic thru the final 1/2 (never had a chance) in the Governor's Cup Futurity. Prior effort (17.64+) he broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start (lead), flashed good speed, gradually pulled clear late (9.63 final 1/8). Gelding is loaded with ability!

SOMEWHAT SPECIAL (16.95) broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, drifted out (2-lanes) at the gap, -2 lengths past the gap, finished out with good energy after losing her best chance (9.62 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.67) she broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 1/2 lengths pas the gap, not abused, finished out full of run after losing her best chance. She is coming off 4-consecutive troubled trips.

THE REVENANT (17.48) broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -1 length, drifted out at the gap (-1 1/2 length), straightened midway, finished out strong (9.54 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.71) he bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.60 final 1/8). Consistent performer yet to run a dull performance!

DIAMONDS BLUE EYE (15.38) broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), drifted in (3-4 lanes) midway, gradually pulled clear late (9.76 final 1/8) while under a hand ride vs. The Plan Overnight handicap winner YANQUE (17.97 winner).

PERFECT AS CAN BE was moving as the gates opened, broke off balance at the start, losing -2 lengths, losing path past the gap (toss it out) in the Kindergarten Futurity. Prior effort (15.62) she broke out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage midway, gradually pulled clear late (getting stronger with each stride). Fresh filly returns with a series of 'turn and works' under K Watanabe.

REMEMBER THE ROSE (17.80) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1 length, put in a big run midway, gained the advantage past the 1/16 pole, held strong (9.73 final 1/8) in the Ed Burke Million trials. Prior effort (15.55) she broke in at the start, losing -1/2 length, raced -1 length past the gap, kept to her task and wasn't beaten badly for it all.

HES OUR FAVORITE (15.52) bumped at the start, quick in stride, gained the advantage past the gap, flashed good speed, held strong (9.82 final 1/8) when favorably drawn. MAKES HIS 2ND START AS A GELDING.

ROYAL TRICKY LADY broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing -2 lengths, losing path (toss it out). Prior effort (18.0) she broke well, quick in stride, bumped early, -1 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.74 final 1/8) from the rail.

CHICKAKID (16.77) broke -1 length slow, drifted in early, raced -1 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (9.62 final 1/8) from the rail. Prior effort (17.88) she bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, raced -3/4 length past the gap, kept to her task to the end (9.68 final 1/8). Trouble-prone filly improves her post!

MCFARLAND USA (15.48) bumped at the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted out (2-lanes) midway (lead), gradually pulled clear late (9.84 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.47)he broke in at the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted in past the gap, gained the advantage midway, held gamely (9.85 final 1/8). Fresh performer and is seeking his 3rd consecutive win!

MR CAPTAIN AMERICA (15.45) was moving as the gates opened, losing -2 lengths, -2 lengths past the gap, kept to his task and wasn't beaten badly for 2nd (9.80 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.54) he broke -1 length slow, bumped repeatedly past the gap, bumped midway, gamely kept to his task to the end (9.87 final 1/8).

WORKER (15.60) bumped (pushed in) shortly after the start, losing -1 length, accelerated nicely, right there past the gap, kept to his task to the end (9.82 final 1/8). He posted a solid "B+" work earlier (08/01).

ROYAL FOOSEPERRYPIC (15.59) broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held strong when favorably drawn (9.87 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.66) she broke -1/2 length slow, quick in stride, right there past the gap, shifted in past the 1/16 pole, gamely kept to her task to the end (SHOULD HAVE WON).

AMORE DI LA MAMMA (15.74) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, losing -1/2 length, quick in stride, right there past the gap, kept to her task to the end (holding 2nd) thru the 9.88 final 1/8. Prior effort she broke off balance, drifted in, bumped shortly after the start, losing -3/4 length, drifted in past the gap, caught in tight quarters (shuffled back) thru the final 1/2.

HORSES TO WATCH:

ENERGETIC broke in at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, wide path, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (actually just missed 2nd) thru the 9.76 final 1/8. Prior effort (16.92) he broke out, bumped at the start, losing -2 lengths, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late. He is much better than his record shows!

JUST WALK BY (15.39) broke off balance, drifted out shortly after the start, quick in stride (lead), lugged out (4-5 lanes) all the way past the gap, held gamely despite lugging out thru the final 1/2 (9.82 final 1/8). Prior effort (17.94) she broke off balance, drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, bumped at the gap, leveled too late.

OTHERS:

LIVE IT UP (15.70) broke off balance, drifted in shortly after the start, quick in stride, right there past the gap, kept to his task and proved best (9.91 final 1/8). Prior effort he broke off balance, bumped (knocked off stride) shortly after the start, bumped repeatedly, cleared past the gap, leveled too late. Makes his 2nd start with the blinkers off.

SUMMERTIME FAVORITE broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, drifted in at the gap, -1 length past the gap, losing path midway (toss it out). Prior effort she bumped, drifted out, bumped (again) shortly after the start, raced in tight quarters (bumped repeatedly) early, losing path past the gap. Trouble prone filly now must flee the rail.

ALAMODE (15.52) broke out, bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), losing lead past the gap, battled back and just missed (9.82 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.43) he broke well, drifted out (2-3 lanes) all the way past the gap, -1 1/2 length past the gap, finished strong (SHOULD HAVE WON). He carries a tendency of lugging out.....
