HORSES TO WATCH:

BELLA RAQUELLA bumped at the start, racing 6-7 lanes wide (-3 lengths) mid-backside, 4-wide to the far turn (22.68 opening quarter), -4 lengths entering the stretch (3-wide), rallied too late (actually just missed 2nd) thru the 6.35 final 1/16. Prior effort she broke well, chased the lone speed WINNER mid-backside (-5 lengths), -5 lengths near the far turn (22.56 opening quarter), raced in TRAFFIC (shuffled back) mid-final turn, LACKED ROOM entering the stretch, had much run left crossing the wire. ADDS THE BLINKERS AND IMPROVES HER POST!

LADY SIF broke well, dueled inside one rival near the far turn (22.68 opening quarter), dropped back -1 length as the pace quickened entering the stretch, got tired in deep stretch (6.35 final 1/16) vs. 3rd place finisher BELLA RAQUELLA. Prior effort she broke in, bumped at the start, -1 length mid-backside, dueled outside the eventual winner near the far turn (22.56 opening quarter), dropped back -4 lengths mid-final turn, -5 lengths entering the stretch, lacked the needed response down the lane. HER SPEED STAMPS HER A CONTENDER.

SHE'S MOVIN ON overmatched in last. Prior effort she broke well, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-6 lengths), -6 lengths near the far turn (22.28 opening quarter), gamely kept to her task to the end (6.35 final 1/16) vs. 3rd place finisher BELLAS RAQUELLA.

BIG EIGHT shortens up after another dull performance. She sports a series of works under M Stortz. Adds aggressive rider (O Santos) aboard. She fits well for sure.

EDELMIRA broke off balance at the start, losing -2 lengths, dropped back -9 lengths mid-backside (chasing the dueling pair), could not keep up entering the stretch. She flashed big speed in her debut when facing a much tougher field at Del Mar. She adds the blinkers!!

MY GIRL SUNNY broke well, chase the lone speed runner mid-backside (-3 lengths), -2 lengths near the far turn (23.60 opening quarter), lacked the needed response entering the stretch at 5 1/2 furlongs at Santa Rosa (Fair Circuit). Privately purchased from J Josephson. Watch the toteboard at this one. SHE COULD BE LIVE (you were warned).

CHARITY MOON bumped at the start, losing - 2 lengths, chased the dueling pair mid-backside (-6 lengths), -10 lengths around the far turn (22.12 opening quarter), lacked a rally down the lane. Fresh thoroughbred sports a series of ordinary works.

HORSES TO WATCH:

HEART THRU FIRE SWERVED IN (3-LANES) SHORTLY AFTER THE START (LOSING ACTION), LOSING -3 1/2 LENGTHS, not abused, STRANGLING DOWN, APPEARING FULL OF RUN CROSSING THE WIRE. HE POSTED A SOLID "B+ " WORK EARLIER (04/22). MAKES 1ST START AS A GELDING!!

SMITH (15.69) broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished strong (actually just missed 2nd). (Q) 09/12 worked solo (12.2) broke well, quick in stride, drifted in early, flashed good speed, drifted in midway, responding strong under light pressure. GRADE: B+ DRILL MAKES HIS 1ST START AS A GELDING!

PEIGHTN YOUR FATE (Q) 09/09 BEST over POLITICAL CANDY (12.7-12.2) Worked outside. Broke well, quick in stride, drifted out, hand shoved, +3 length advantage midway, responding strong under light pressure. Winning by +4 1/2 lengths. GRADE: A-DRILL.

OTHERS:

STRIVEN (15.85) pinballed at the start, bumped repeatedly to the gap, CLEARED MIDWAY, finished out with good energy (should have been much closer). (Q) 08/12 outworked by BETTER THAN EVER (both 12.3) Worked outside. Broke in, bumped at the start, quick in stride (lead), even up midway (drifted in/bumped), responding well. Even up GRADE B+ DRILL Better is forecast with the race under his belt.

DR CORONAS GOT CASH (Q) 09/09 BEST over SWIFTY SAVANNA (12.7-12.4) Worked outside. Broke well, quick in stride (lead), +1 length advantage midway, never asked, responding strong under light pressure. Winning by +2 lengths. GRADE: B+ DRILL (Q) 08/22 BEST over SWIFLY SAVANNA (12.8-12.7) Worked outside. Broke well, quick in stride (lead), drifted out early, let run, responding well. Winning by a narrow margin. GRADE: C+ DRILL

JESS BET ME broke off balance at the start, losing -2 lengths, losing path, not abused, lugged out near the wire. He posted a solid "B+" work earlier (06/03).

FAVORITE BYE (15.89) broke off balance at the start, drifted in (2-lanes) to the gap, raced -1 1/2 length past the gap, leveled midway, finished well (actually not beaten badly for 2nd) thru the 9.82 final 1/8. (Q) 09/09 outworked by DEVIL IN A BLUE SUIT (12.4-12.6) Worked outside. Hesitated, drifted out (2-lanes) shortly after the start, hand shoved, -1 length midway, responding well under light pressure. Losing by -1 length. GRADE: C+ DRILL

FENIAN FAITH arrives from New Mexico. Competed in a pair of trials. Worth a look at the betting board.

AR ROYAL BLUE (Q) 09/12 outworked (12.3-12.5-12.7) Worked outside. Broke out (2-lanes) at the start, asked immediately, -3 lengths midway, not used. GRADE: C+ DRILL (Q) 08/29 outworked (12.2-12.4-12.8) Worked outside. Hesitated, broke out (2-3 lanes) shortly after the start, not quick, -4 1/2 lengths midway, not abused, plenty left. Losing by -3 lengths. GRADE: C+ DRILL

MAJOR WIN PLAYER:

DRAMATIC ANGEL broke out, bumped at the start, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-4 lengths), -2 lengths near the far turn (22.37 opening quarter), cleared inside at midstretch, rallied too late (6.37 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke out, bumped at the start, chased the lone speed runner mid-backside (-8 lengths), lacked the needed response down the lane vs. TOUGHER RIVALS. Versatile performer will be facing a pair of speed rivals (FAST LANE LARRY and CALIBRASKA) in this lineup.

OTHERS:

CITORI broke out, bumped at the start, losing -2 lengths, chased the 3-horse speed duel mid-backside (-4 lengths), put in a good run to the far turn (22.40 opening quarter), raced in TRAFFIC (shuffled back) mid-final turn (-4 lengths), traveled evenly down the lane after losing his best chance. Prior effort he broke -2 lengths slow, chased the lone speed winner mid-backside (-3 lengths), -5 lengths near the far turn (22.36 opening quarter), kept to his task to the end. He will be making only his 2nd start since 07/07.

CALIBRASKA broke well, dueled outside 2-rivals near the far turn (22.40 opening quarter), dueled outside one rival mid-final turn, dropped back -1 length as the pace quickened entering the stretch (fanned 3-4 lanes wide), tired understandably at midstretch (6.32 final 1/16). Prior effort he broke in, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced in traffic early, -2 lengths mid-backside (chasing the 3-horse speed duel), fanned 4-5 lanes wide near the far turn (22.46 opening quarter), gamely kept to his task to the end. She must deal with FAST LANE LARRY for the early lead.
