HORSES TO WATCH:

FAVORITE BLING (15.35) broke off balance, drifted out (3-4 lanes) shortly after the start, accelerated nicely (lead), lugged out (3-4 lanes) past the gap, lugged out throughout, gamely kept to her task for the score (9.93 final 1/8). Prior effort (15.67) she broke out, bumped at the start, losing -1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, not abused, finished out full of run after losing her best chance vs. maidens. Hard to ride performer (lugging in problems) holds the highest ratings based on adjusted clocking of 15.35 for 300 yards!

DATING GAME (15.37) broke well, quick in stride (lead), drifted out at the gap, drifted in past the 1/16 pole, flashed good speed, just missed (tough loss) thru the 9.93 final 1/8 when favorably drawn. Prior effort (17.08) she broke off balance, bumped shortly after the start, losing - 1 length, raced -2 lengths past the gap, leveled too late (9.80 final 1/8). She must maintain a straight course (encountered trouble of all her 6 outings).

PURITAN (16.94) he broke off balance at the start, quick in stride, raced -3/4 length past the gap, put in a big run midway, rallied to the front past the 1/16 pole, held strong (9.82 final 1/8). Prior effort he swerved in at the start, bumped repeatedly all the way past the gap (losing path), leveled too late (running behind horses). He draws a favorable outside post.

OTHERS:

GALAXY CZECH broke -1/2 length slow, drifted in early, drifted in (bumped) past the gap, losing path midway, cleared too late, finished out with good energy after losing her best chance. Prior effort (15.89) she broke well, quick in stride (lead), flashed good speed, held gamely vs. maiden \$10,000-claimers.

ROYAL TRICKY LADY broke in at the start, losing -1 1/2 length, losing path at the gap (toss it out) in the PCQHRA Breeders Futurity trials vs. productive field (top 2 finishers qualified for the PCQHRA Futurity). Prior effort she drifted out, bumped shortly after the start, losing - 2 lengths, losing path, finished out with much run left after losing her best chance. She must flee the rail tonight.

SP FOUR SQUARE Inter-mountain performer qualified for the Idaho futurity. Hails from winning connections. A toteboard check is advised.

Hesitated, broke out at the start, losing -2 lengths, hand shoved for speed, - 1 1/2 length midway, responding strong under light pressure. Even up. GRADE: B+ DRILL (Q) 08/15 BEST over FIVE CARD CHARLIE (12.4-12.3) Worked outside. Hesitated slightly at the start, losing - 1 1/2 length, hand shoved, -1 length midway, responding strong (plenty left). Winning by +1/2 length. GRADE: B+ DRILL BIG CHANCE TO WIN THIS ONE IF SHE BREAKS ALERTLY!
